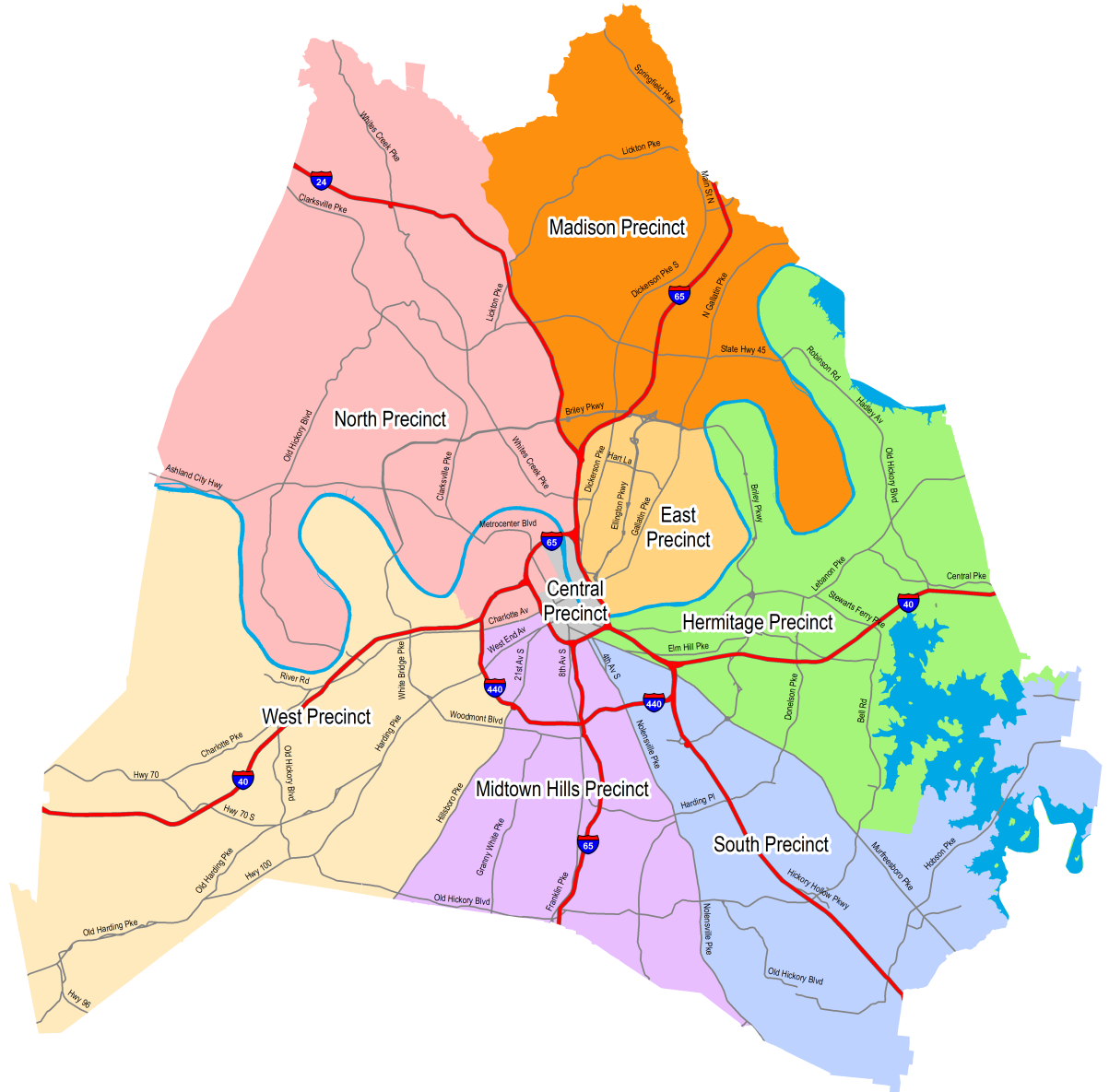

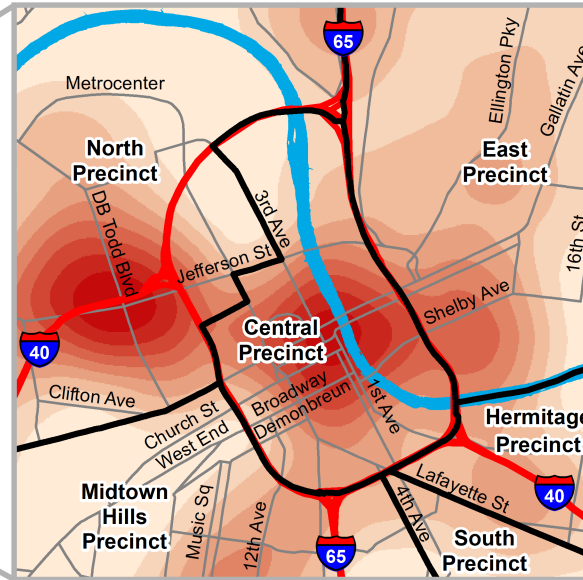
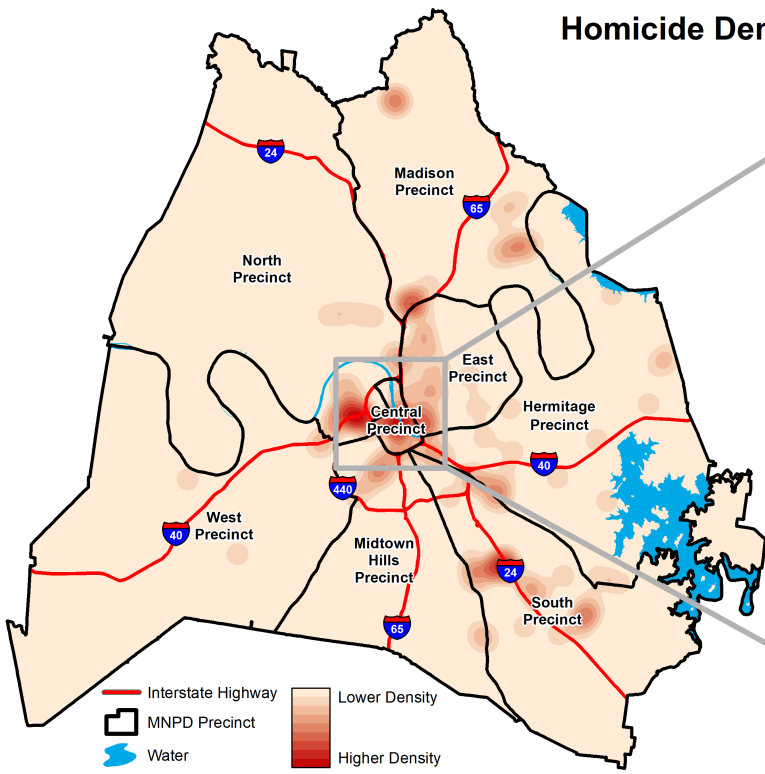

Homicide Density Map and Victim / Suspect Report 1/1/2022 - 12/31/2022

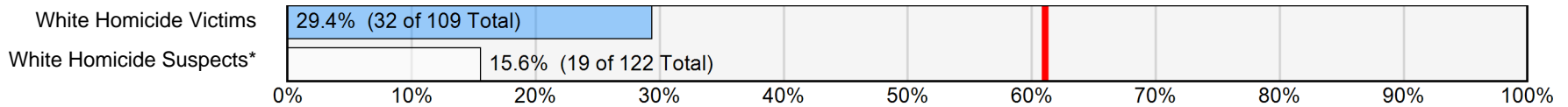

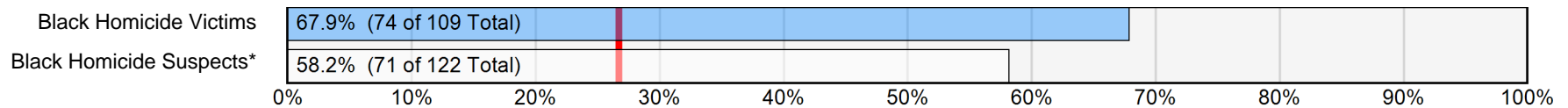

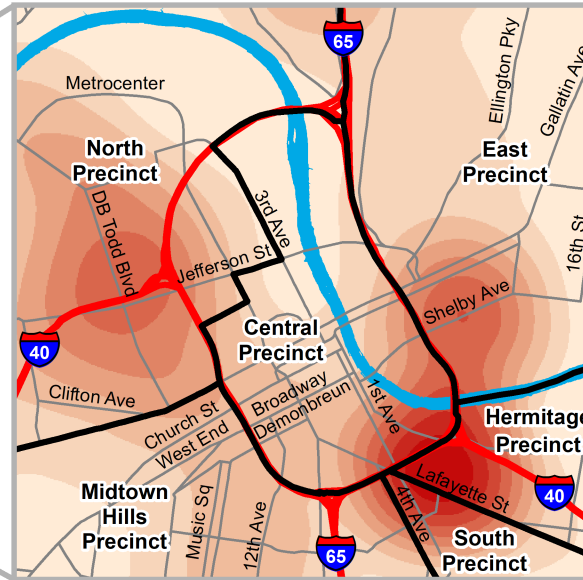

Gunshot Injury Density Map and Victim / Suspect Report 1/1/2022 - 12/31/2022

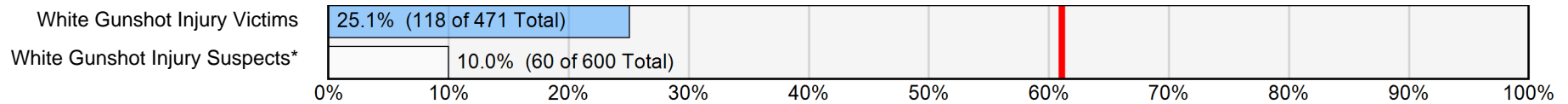

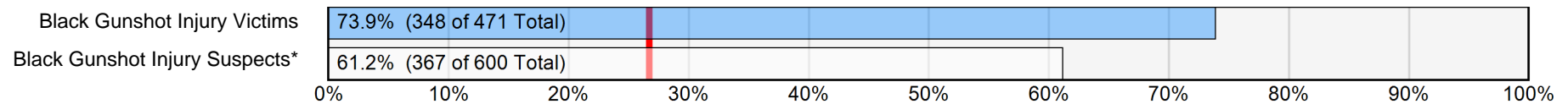

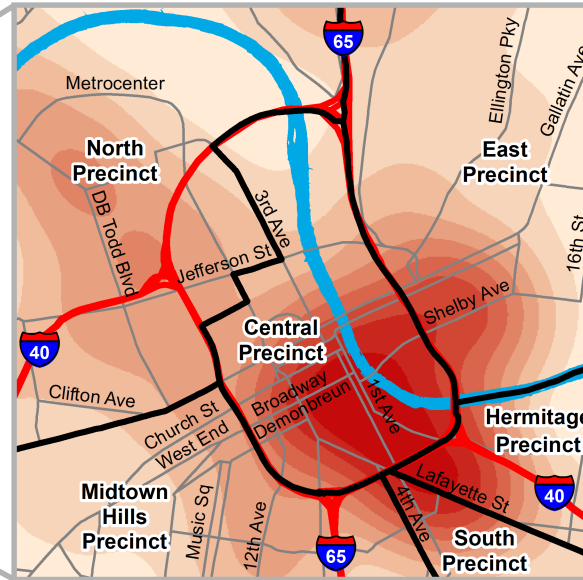

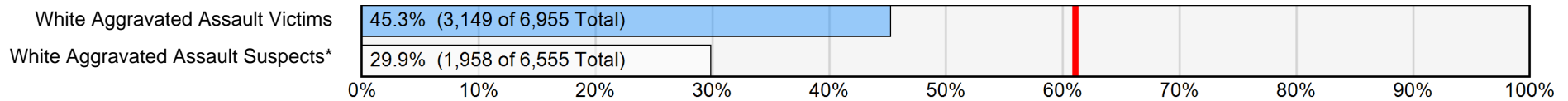

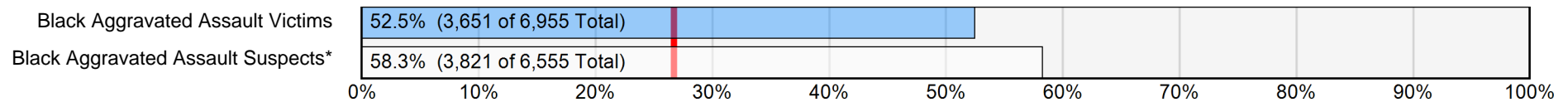

Street Robbery Density Map and Victim / Suspect Report 1/1/2022 - 12/31/2022

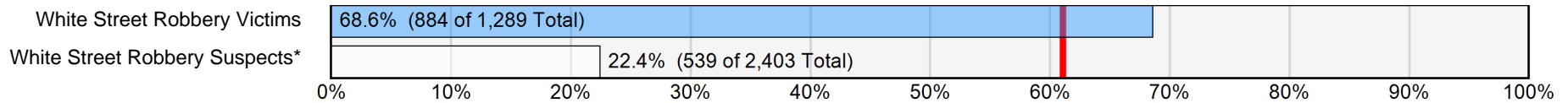

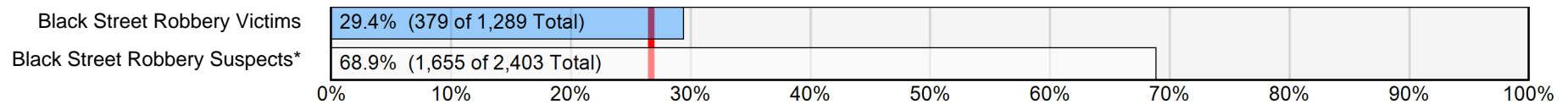

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Carjacking Density Map and Victim / Suspect Report 1/1/2022 - 12/31/2022

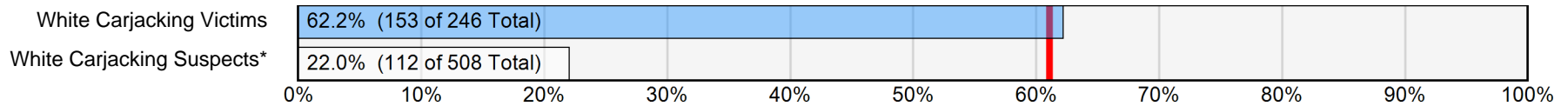

Market Robbery Density Map and Victim / Suspect Report 1/1/2022 - 12/31/2022

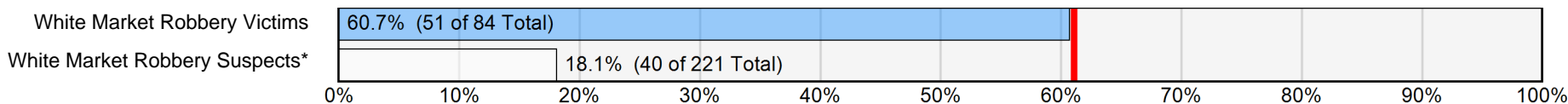

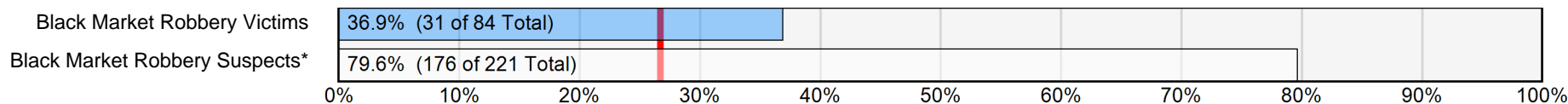

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Commercial Robbery Density Map and Victim / Suspect Report 1/1/2022 - 12/31/2022

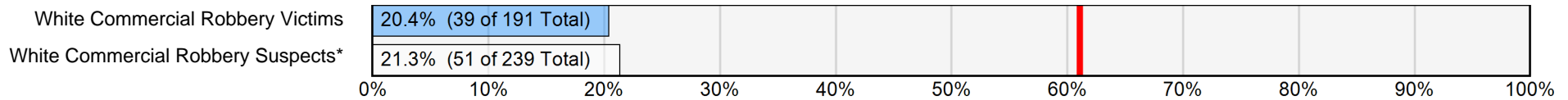

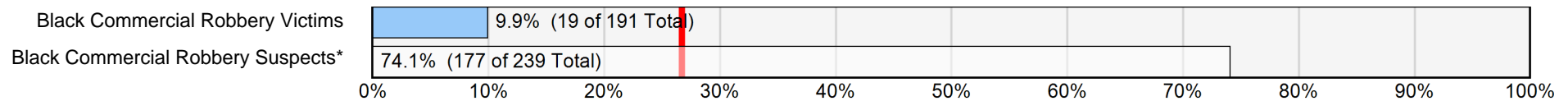

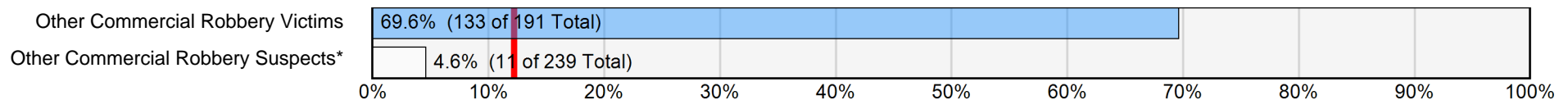

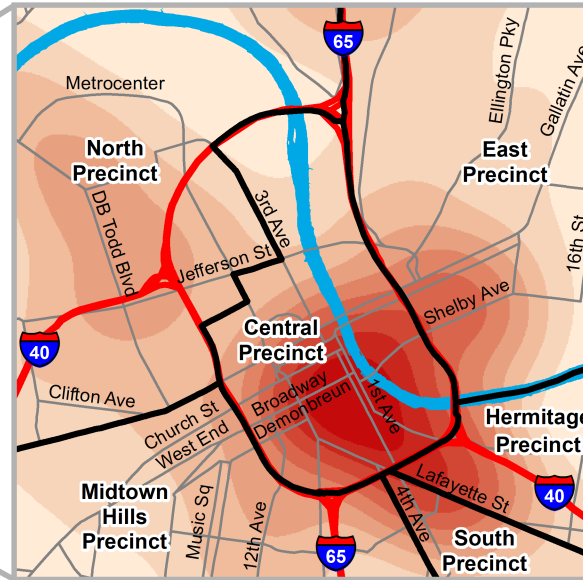

Violent Incident Density Map and Victim / Suspect Report 1/1/2022 - 12/31/2022

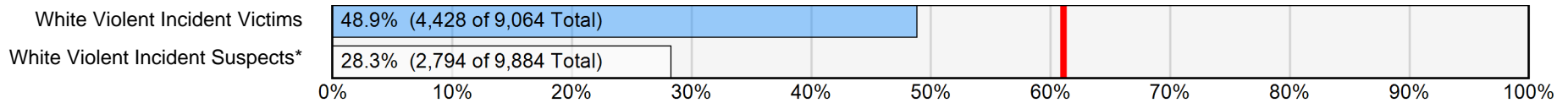

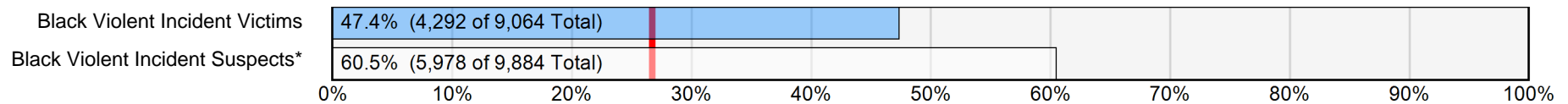

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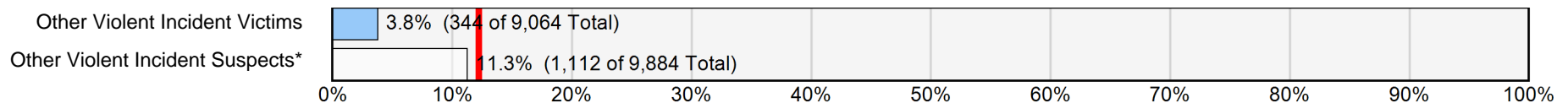

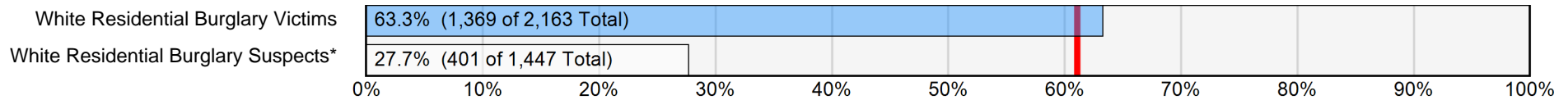

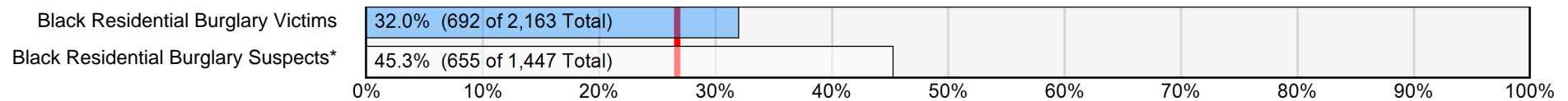

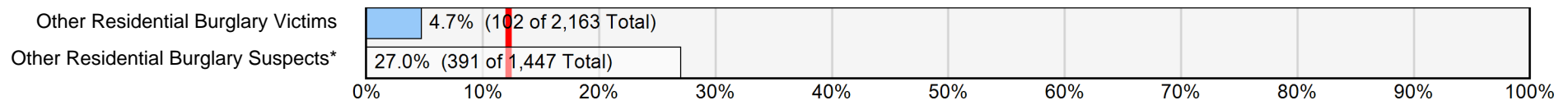

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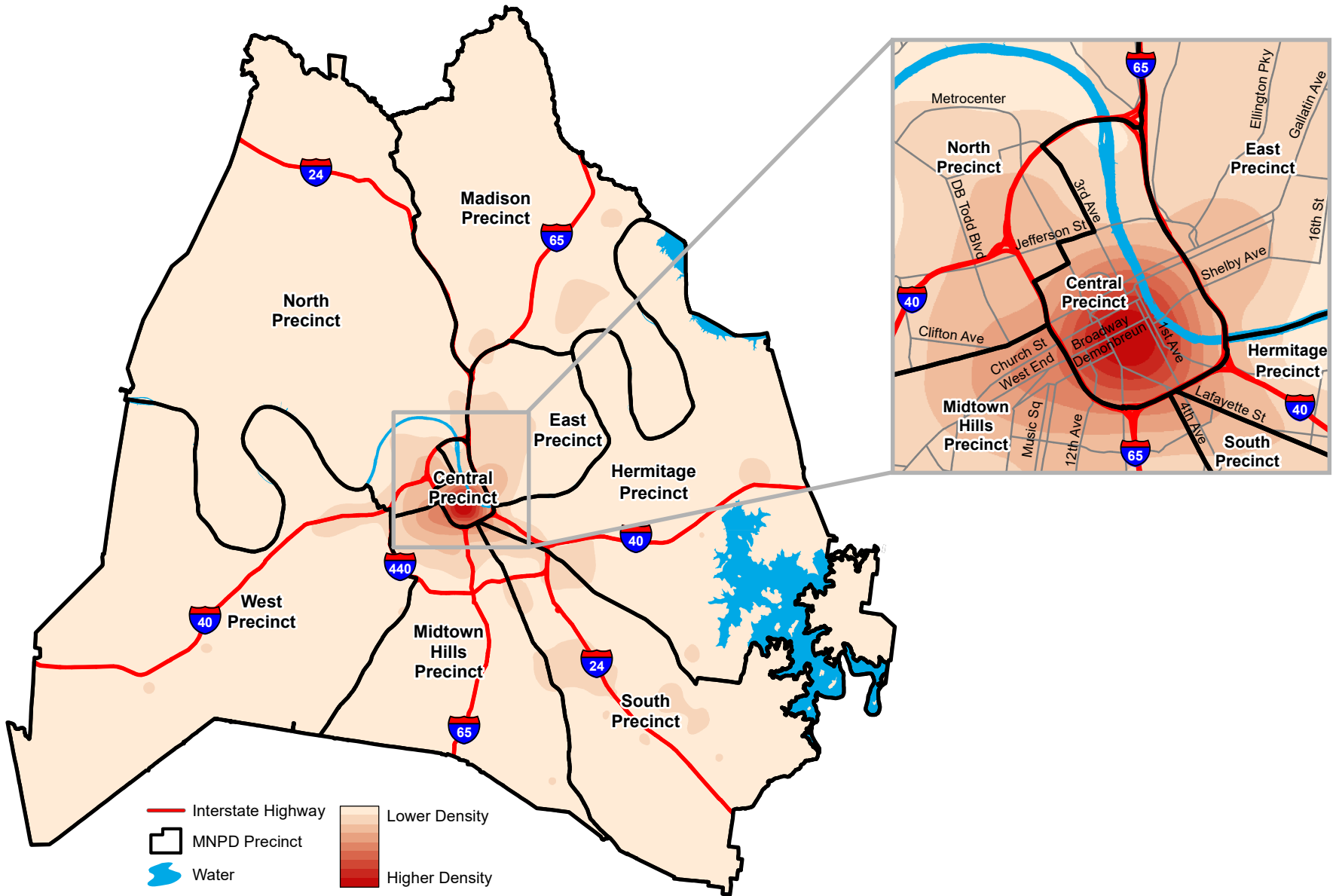

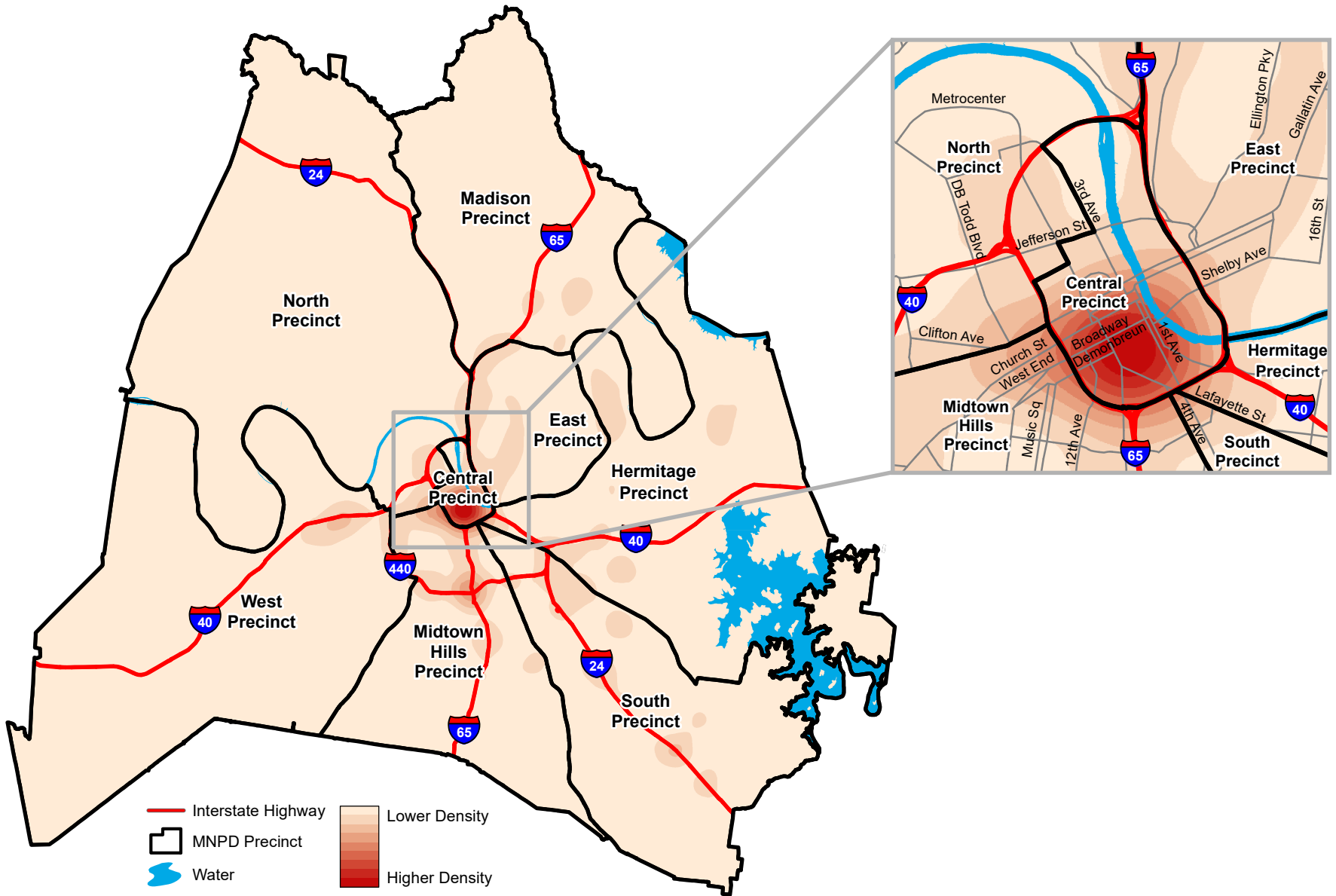

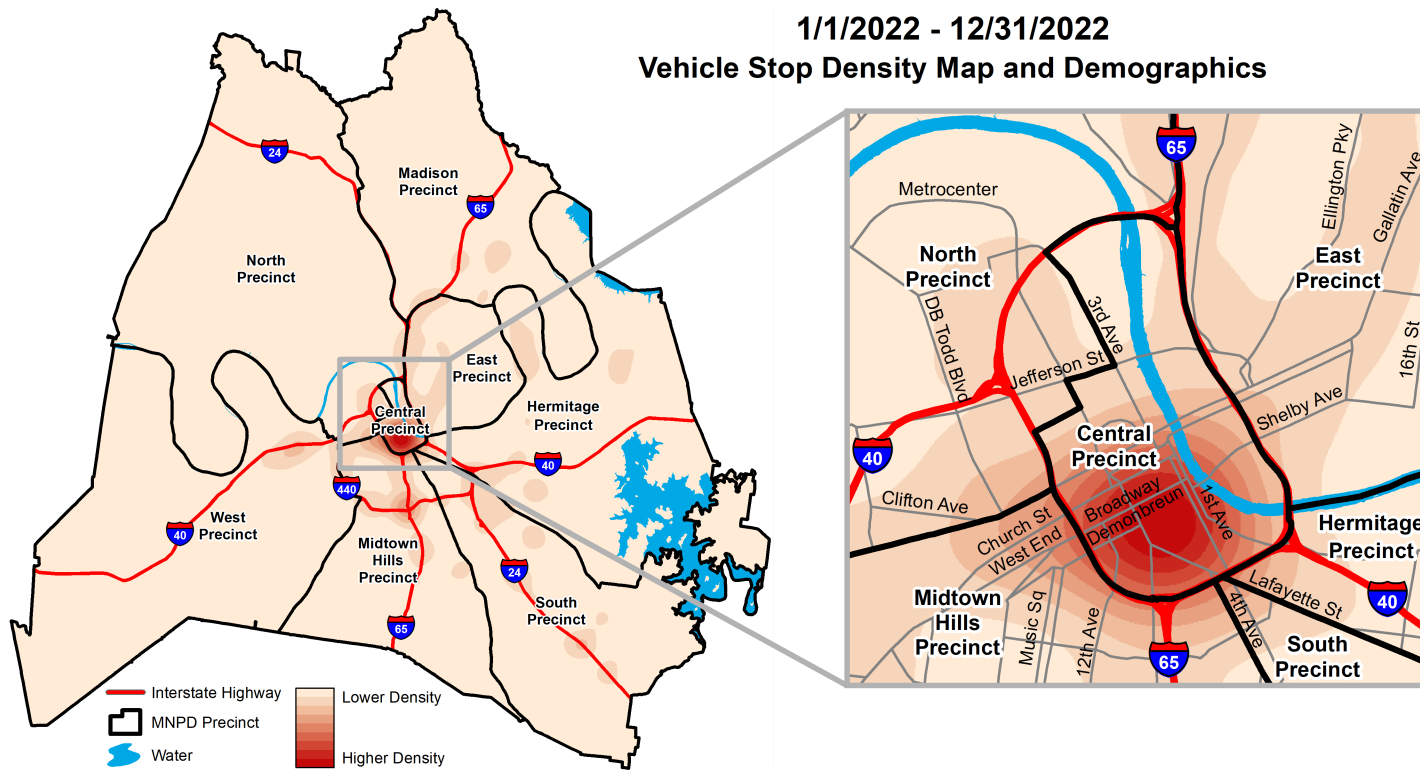
Vehicle Stop Density Map

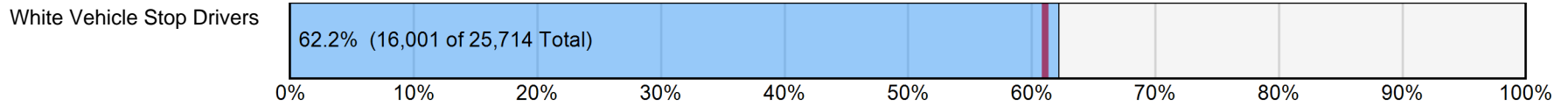

1/1/2022 - 12/31/2022 Vehicle Stop Density Map and Demographics



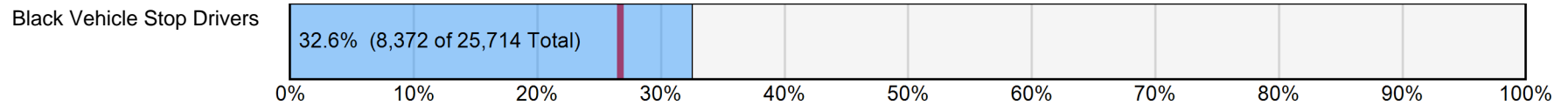

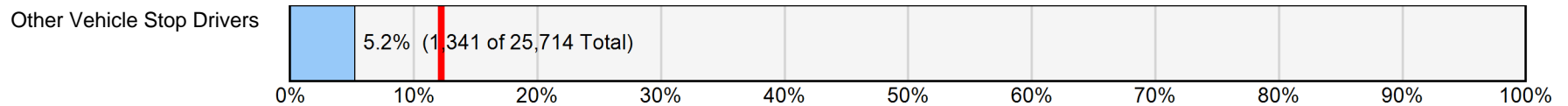
Black Drivers Stopped: 1/1/2022 - 12/31/2022

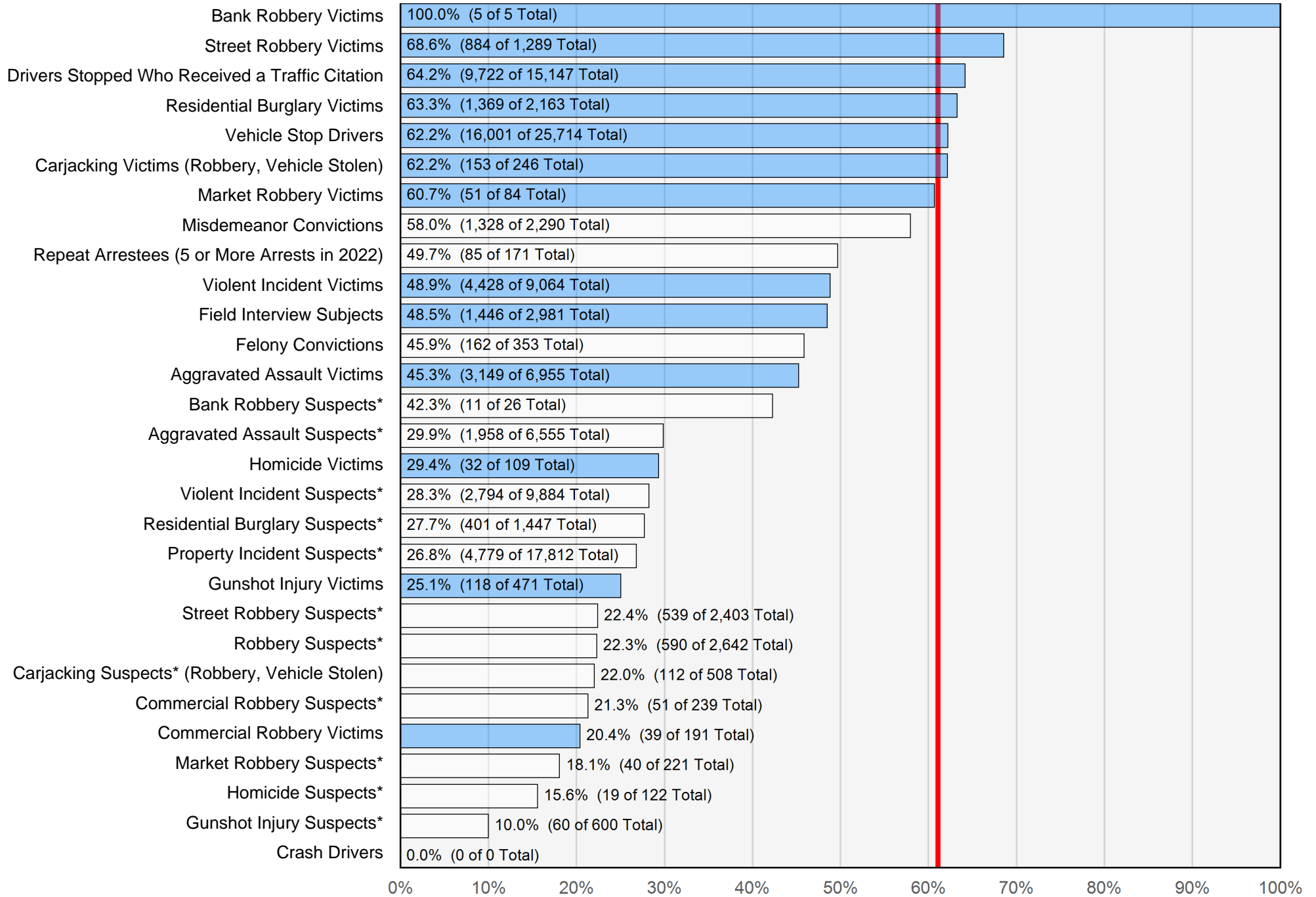

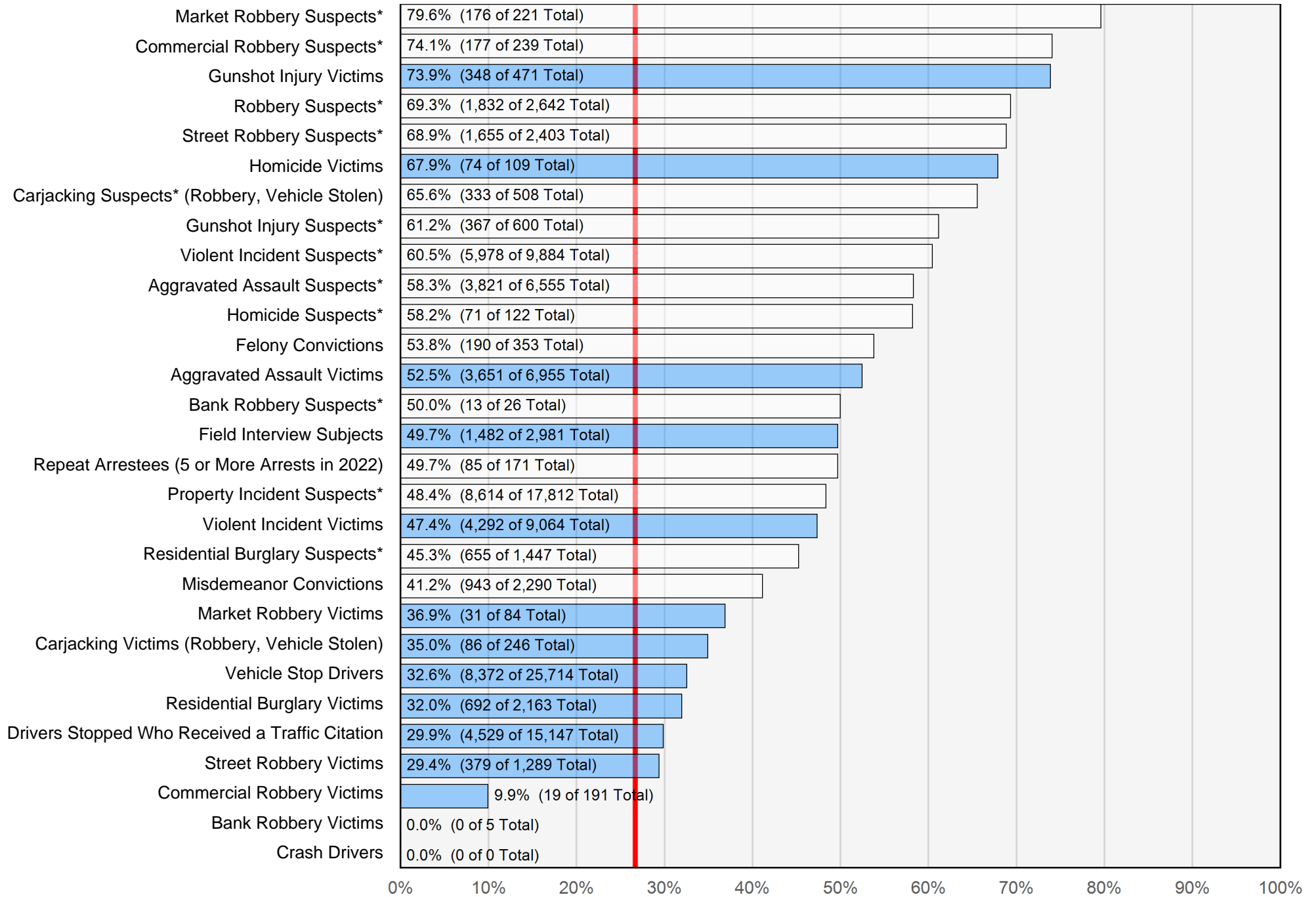

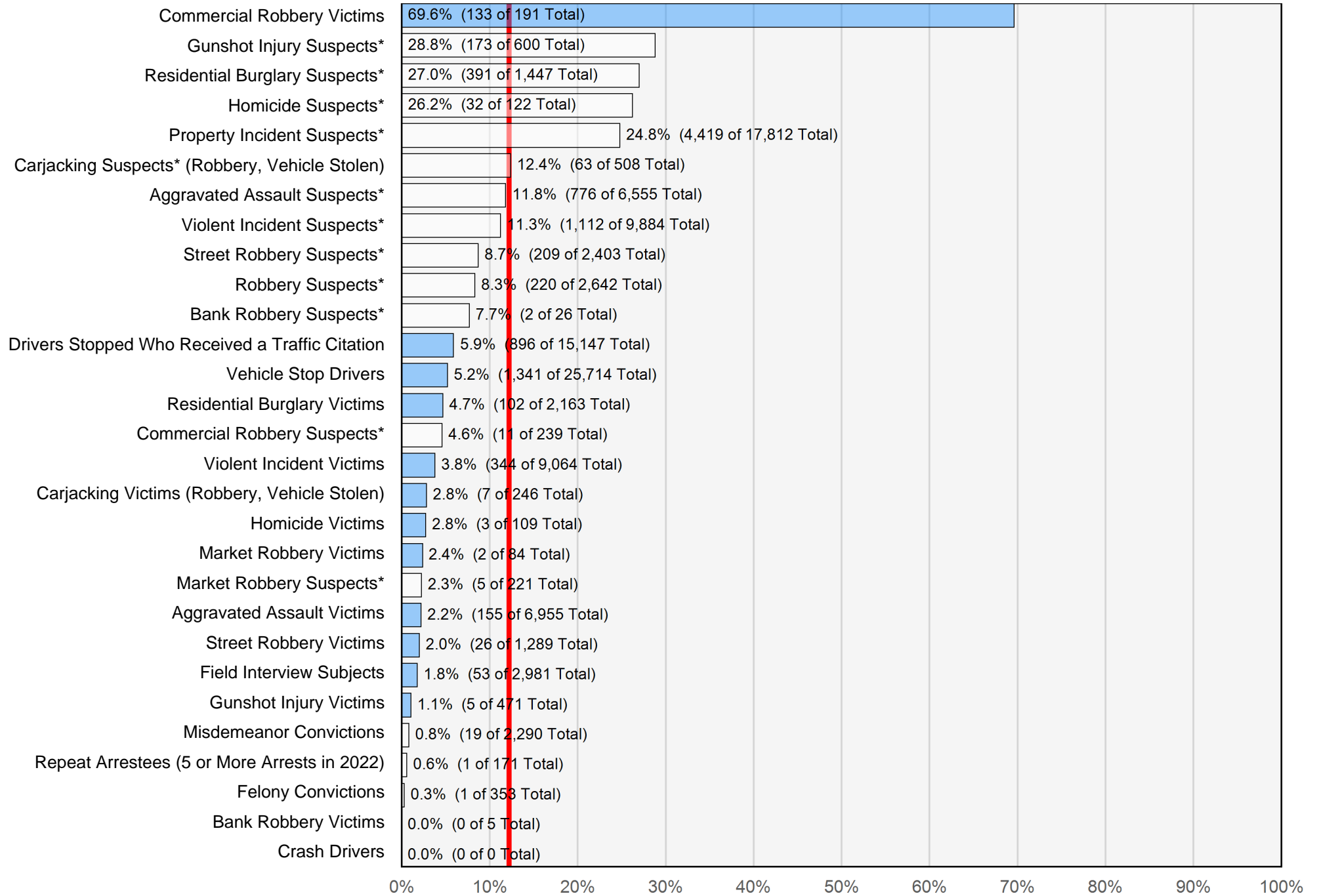

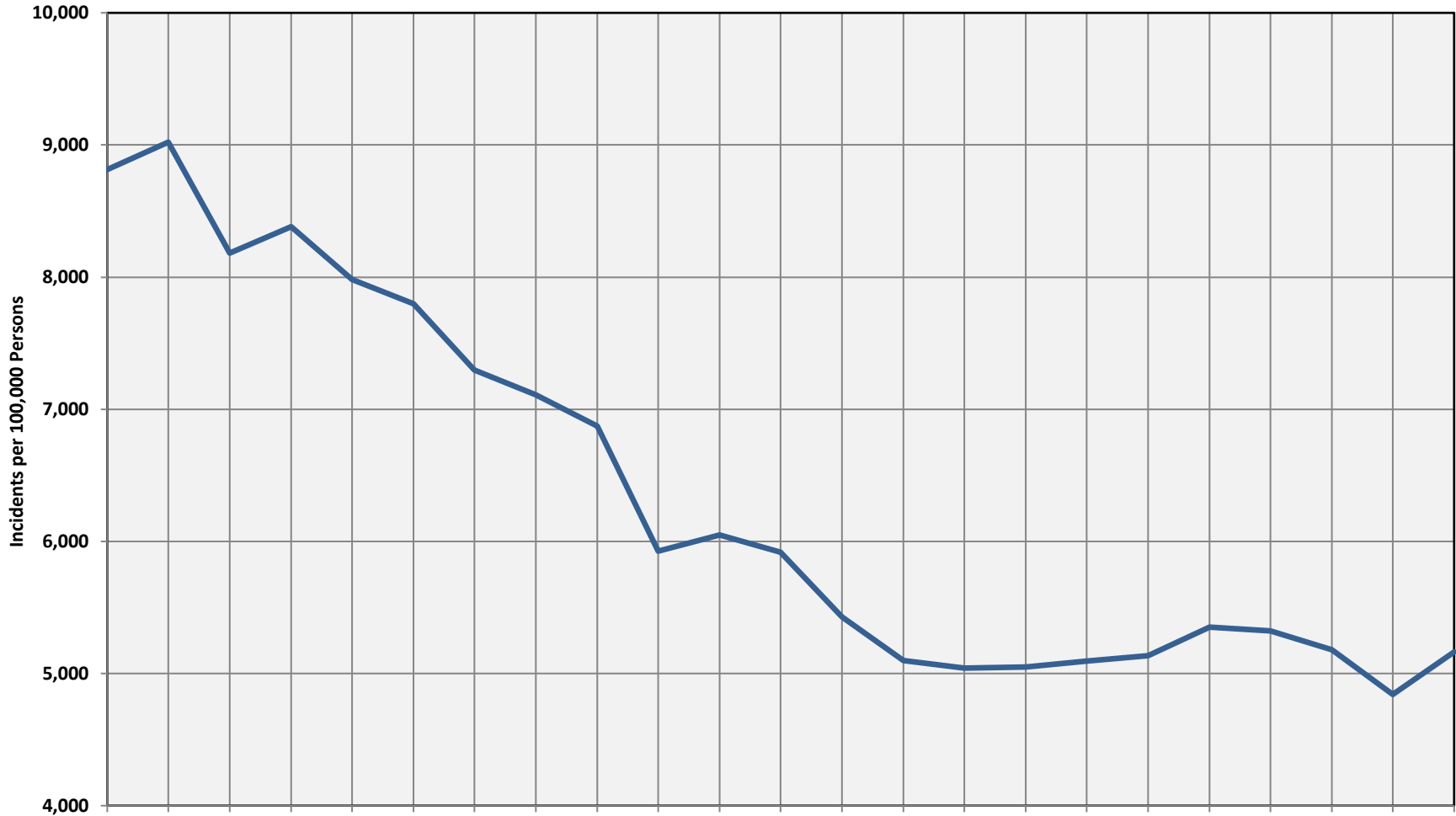

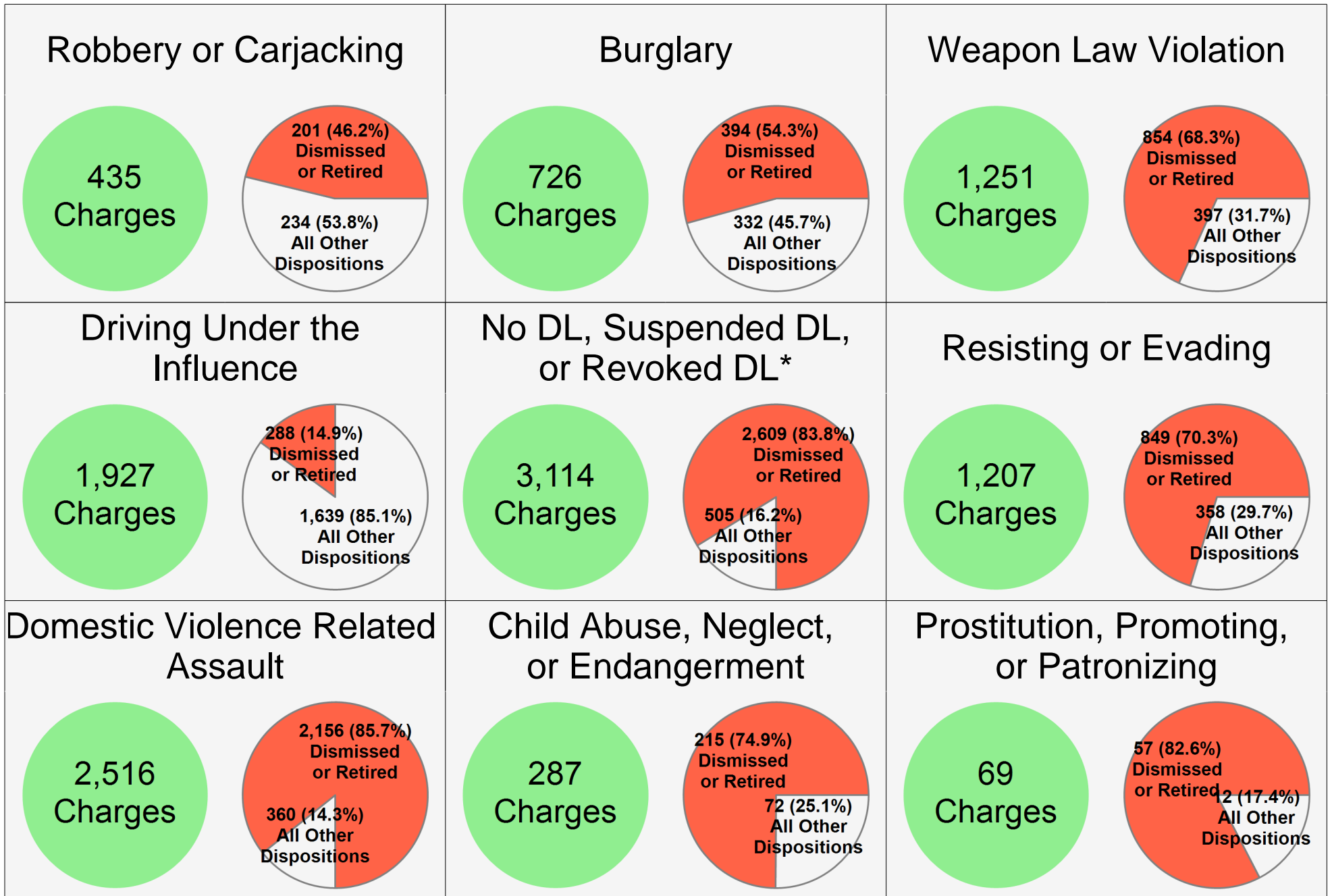
