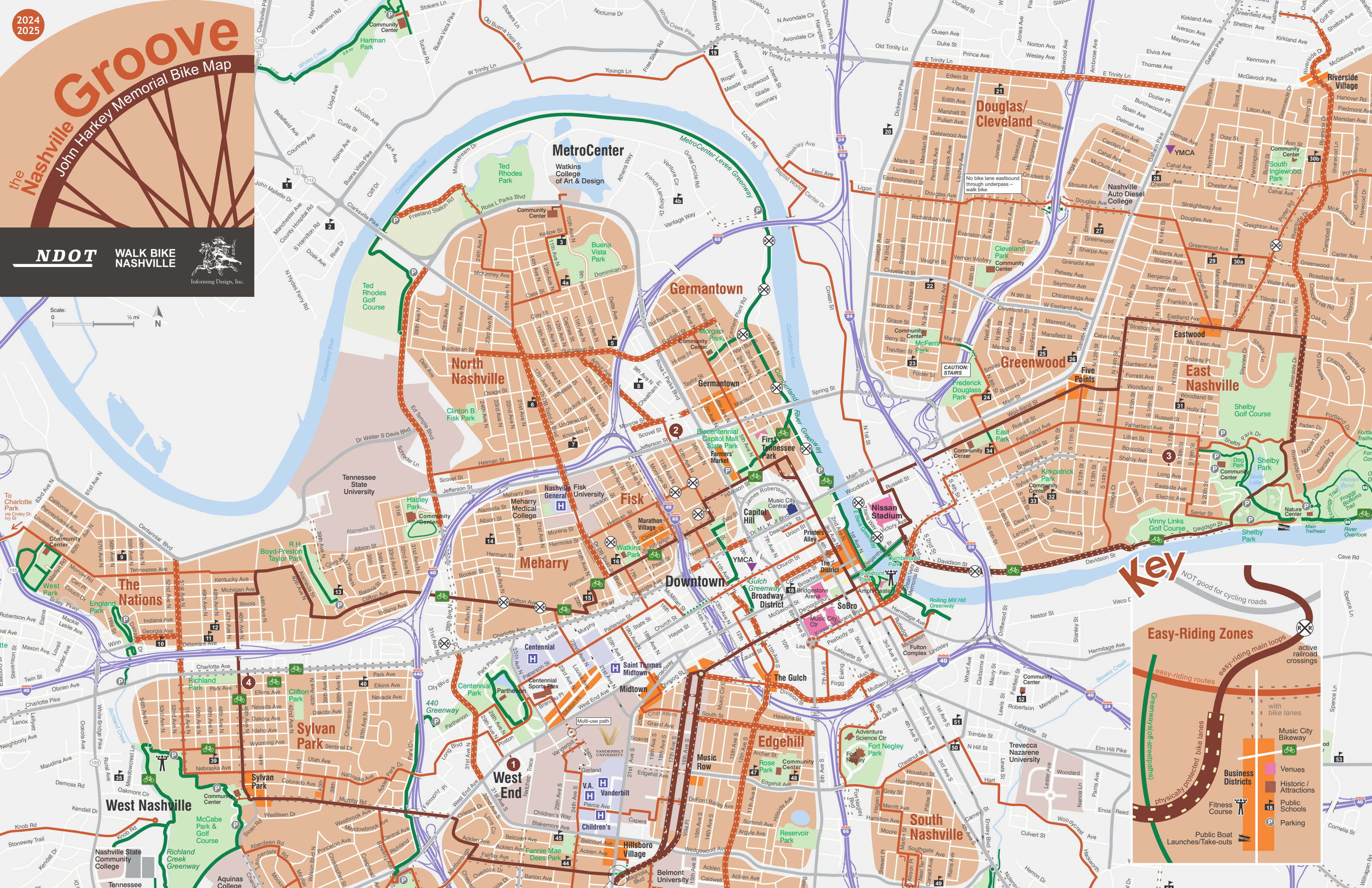

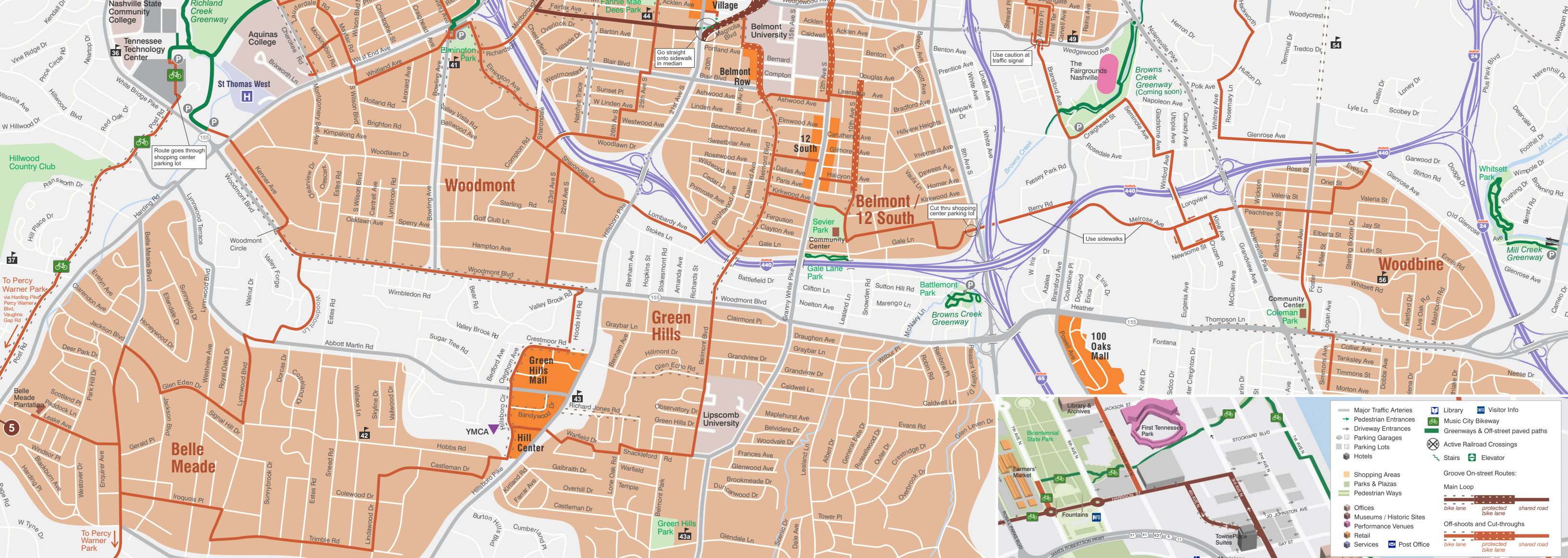

Walk Bike Nashville is a 25 year old organization dedicated to making Nashville more walkable, bikeable, and livable for all. www.walkbikenashville.org

Greenways for Nashville raises awareness of and private support for Nashville's greenways initiative. Nashville currently has 99 miles of paved, off-street greenways for walking and biking. www.greenwaysformashville.org

WeGo Public Transit is Nashville's public transit system with bike racks on all its buses. E-bikes weighing 55lb or less — and with a maximum tire width of 2" — may be used on the racks. www.wegotransit.com

BCycle is an electric pedal-assist bike share system in Nashville with over 30 stations. Bike rental can be via a pass or the bicycle app. For more info: www.nashville.bcycle.com

The Music City Bikeway is a continuous 26 mile bicycle route stretching from Percy Warner Park in southwestern Davidson County to Percy Priest Dam in the far eastern part. Find the link to a map on the Walk Bike web site.
