Minutes

September 27, 2012

The Metropolitan Nashville-Davidson County Transportation Commission (TLC) met in regular session on this date at the Metropolitan Courthouse. Present were Commissioners Sal Hernandez, Rhonda Marko, Sam Patel, Tom Turner and Curt Wallen (5). Also present were Metro Legal Advisers Theresa Costonis and Rachelle Gallimore-Scruggs along with TLC staff members Lisa Steelman, Milton Bowling, Howard Morris and Interim Director Billy Fields.

Chair Helen Rogers was unable to be present as was Vice Chair Brian Winfrey so the Commission selected Commissioner Hernandez to chair the meeting.

Commissioner Hernandez called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance and then read the Notice of Appeal Statement which outlined the right of appeal for TLC decision.
