**VII. NEW BUSINESS**

- 06-21-03** Friends of Shelby Park and Bottoms requests board approval of an amendment to our previously approved grant request as it relates to the Repair of the Mission Shelter by Lake Sevier. No changes are proposed to the funding structure – all costs will be borne by Friends of Shelby Park and Bottoms. The total cost of \$35,000 mentioned in the previous grant request for repairs to the Mission Shelter is an estimate. Friends of Shelby Park & Bottoms will cover any additional costs over this amount. The shelter was damaged when a tree fell on it in January 2020. Friends of Shelby proposes to hire the Metro Parks carpenters to complete the framing and painting work and use professional contractors for the roofing. Each month Friends of Shelby Park & Bottoms will receive an invoice from Metro Parks for the carpenter payroll amounts associated with the repairs to the Mission Shelter. Parks will then invoice Friends of Shelby Park & Bottoms for the payroll amounts to be reimbursed.
- 06-21-04** Metro Parks is requesting approval of an Agreement for Grant of Easement for a Conservation Greenway between Germantown JV LLC and Metro Government, on property owned by Germantown JV LLC located at 1420 Adams Street, Parcel # 0820501770
- 06-21-05** Metro Parks is requesting approval in concept, of a Participation Agreement between Metro and CRP/Alta, LLCA the developers of 200 Cumberland Bend, a multi-family development adjacent to the Cumberland River Greenway trailhead located at 102 Great Circle Road. The Participation Agreement will include design and construction of the improvements, subject to Metro Parks' design approval, and maintenance by the owners of the 200 Cumberland Bend property.
- 06-21-06** Michelle Craine, President of Creative Parks Nashville, requests the Parks Board approval of an in-kind donation for improvements to the Centennial Arts Center shed roof project with an estimated value of \$4,000.00. Improvements include electrical installation and addition of an industrial ceiling fan. In the case that improvements total more than \$4,000.00, Creative Parks Nashville will be responsible for paying those amounts. No money will be donated to Metro Parks. Improvements will be paid for directly by Creative Parks Nashville with no cash match or any other obligation to Metro or Parks.
- 06-21-07** Board to approve open range salary increase and cost of living salary increase, consistent with Metro employees for the Director of Parks as per the 2021-22 Metropolitan Government Pay Plan.

Staff wants to establish record of this history in the event that Shelby Park is ever remodeled or upgraded and may be done according to the original drawings.
