

MINUTES
METROPOLITAN SEXUALLY ORIENTED
BUSINESS LICENSING BOARD

The Sexually Oriented Business Licensing Board held a videoconference meeting via WebEx on January 27, 2021 at 4:00 p.m. Members Jonathan Richardson, Ashley Wood, Lynne Ingram and Amna Osman were present. Member Loren Russell was absent. Attorney Matthew Garth and Inspector Christine Gibson were present. Chairman Jonathan Richardson called the meeting to order at 4:17 p.m.

Mr. Richardson stated, due to Executive Orders 16, 37 and 51, meetings for essential business of this Board be conducted in an electronic format and called for a motion to waive all rules to the contrary. Ms. Wood made the motion to waive all rules to the contrary. Ms. Osman seconded the motion and the Board voted unanimously.

Ms. Wood made the motion to approve the minutes for the meeting of October 28, 2020. Ms. Osman seconded the motion and the Board voted unanimously.

The meeting for November 11, 2020 was canceled; therefore, the following new entertainer permit applications from October 29, 2020 to November 11, 2020 were approved pursuant to Metropolitan Code of Laws Section 6.54.070(C)(2): 3202, 3203, 3204, 3205, 3206, 3207, 3208 and 3209. In addition, the following renewal entertainer permit applications were approved: 2541, 2661, 2741, 2820, 2899, 2900 and 3063. There were no new or renewal business applications during this time period.

The meeting for November 25, 2020 was canceled; therefore, the following new entertainer permit applications from November 12, 2020 to November 25, 2020 were approved pursuant to Metropolitan Code of Laws Section 6.54.070(C)(2): 3210, 3211, 3212, 3213, 3214, 3215 and 3216. In addition, the following renewal entertainer permit applications were approved: 886, 1086, 2419, 2579, 2747 and 2910. There were no new or renewal business applications during this time period.

The meeting for December 9, 2020 was canceled; therefore, the following new entertainer permit applications from November 26, 2020 to December 9, 2020 were approved pursuant to Metropolitan Code of Laws Section 6.54.070(C)(2): 3217, 3218, 3219, 3220, 3221, 3222, 3223, 3224, 3225 and 3226. In addition, the following renewal entertainer permit applications were approved: 236, 946, 1165, 3104 and 3107. There were no new or renewal business applications during this time period.

The meeting for December 23, 2020 was canceled; therefore, the following new entertainer permit applications from December 10, 2020 to December 23, 2020 were approved pursuant to Metropolitan Code of Laws Section 6.54.070(C)(2): 3227, 3228, 3229, 3230 and 3231. In addition, the following renewal entertainer permit applications were approved: 601, 2371, 2896 and 3108. There were no new business applications during this time period. The following renewal business applications were approved pursuant to Metropolitan Code of Laws Section 6.54.070(C)(2): #1638-Jenna's Toy Box, Gallatin Pike South, and #2082-Jenna's Toy Box, Dickerson Pike.

The meeting for January 13, 2021 was canceled; therefore, the following new entertainer permit applications from December 24, 2020 to January 13, 2021 were approved pursuant to Metropolitan Code of Laws Section 6.54.070(C)(2): 3232, 3233, 3234, 3235, 3236 and 3237. In addition, the following renewal entertainer permit applications were approved: 1730, 2086, 2576, 2603, 2794 and 3015. There were no new or renewal business applications during this time period.

Ms. Gibson informed the Board that the following new entertainer permit applications were in order from January 14, 2021 to January 27, 2021: 3238, 3239 and 3240. Ms. Wood made the motion to approve the permits. Ms. Osman seconded the motion and the Board voted unanimously.

Ms. Gibson informed the Board that the following renewal entertainer permit applications were in order from January 14, 2021 to January 27, 2021: 1688, 2037 and 3071. Ms. Wood made the motion to approve the permits. Ms. Osman seconded the motion and the Board voted unanimously. Ms. Gibson informed the Board there were no new or renewal business applications during this time period.

Ms. Gibson presented her Inspector's report to the Board. She advised that the following businesses were in compliance during regular inspections: Pure Gold's Crazy Horse, Déjà vu of Nashville, Jenna's Toy Box (Dickerson Road), Jenna's Toy Box (Gallatin Pike) and Lion's Den. Larry Flynt's Hustler/Kings of Hustler has temporarily closed due to COVID and the mandate to close business hours at 11 p.m. and plan to reopen when the time limit mandate is extended or lifted.

The Board elected new Officers. Ms. Wood made a motion to elect Mr. Richardson as the Chairman of the Board. Ms. Osman seconded the motion and the Board voted unanimously. Ms. Osman made a motion to elect Ms. Wood as the Vice Chairman of the Board. Ms. Ingram seconded the motion and the Board voted unanimously.

This concluded their business. Ms. Wood made the motion to adjourn. Ms. Osman seconded. The Board voted unanimously and adjourned at 4:38 p.m. until the meeting of February 10, 2021 at 4:00 p.m.
