BOARD APPROVES AGREEMENT FOR PARKS POLICE TO PROVIDE LAW ENFORCEMENT PATROLS AT PERCY PRIEST LAKE RECREATION AREA ON AN EXTRA DUTY BASIS

Upon motion of Ms. Haynes, seconded by Ms. Scott-Barnes, the board approved the agreement for Parks Police to provide law enforcement patrols on an extra duty basis.

The fees are our standard \$42 per hour for hiring officers off duty. Since we are using our vehicles in these patrols, we have added a surcharge of \$4.50 per hour to cover the expense of using the vehicles (mileage, gas, insurance, etc.). With that surcharge we will be invoicing a total amount of \$46.50 per hour. Upon approval, this agreement will be effective May 1, 2021.
