The decisions of the Metropolitan Beer Permit Board take effect on a date to be determined by the board. However, you may file an appeal within 60 days of the date of entry of the board's decision. We advise that you seek your own independent legal advice to ensure that your appeal is filed in a timely manner and that all procedural requirements have been met.

Ms. Fox then made a motion for a \$4,200 civil penalty or 14-day suspension followed by 60 days probation. The motion was then seconded by Ms. Jarmon for discussion. Following discussion, the board voted unanimously in favor of the motion.
