**Case Description:** Request is to appeal the adverse decision of Metro Water Services (MWS) National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Program regarding a Notice of Non-Compliance (NON) to Lake Providence Missionary Baptist Church, located at 5891 Nolensville Pike, Nashville, TN 37211 for disturbance of a regulated stream buffer. The no-disturb stream buffer requirements went into effect as a result of the original development activity under grading permit 2001-096.

A Notice of Non-Compliance was presented to Lake Providence August 14, 2020 informing the church that it was in violation of no-disturb stream buffer requirements that went into effect as a result of the original development activity under grading permit 2001-096. Notice stated, "cutting the trees disturbed a regulated stream buffer" and was in direct violation of Metro Nashville Stormwater Management Manual Section 6.9. The Appellant is appealing the decision of Metro Water Services.

- 2. Continuous mowing & maintenance of the buffer
