Your appeal must be filed within 60 days of the date of the entry of the Commission’s decision. We advise that you seek your own independent legal advice to ensure that your appeal is filed in a timely manner and that all procedural requirements have been met.”

- a) CD 21: Mandatory referral 2021M-008AB-001: A request for the abandonment of a portion of right-of-way and easements along Booker Street, measuring approximately 10 foot by 113 foot, along the south property line of property located at 745 22nd North Court; requested by Catalyst Design Group.
- b) CD 08: Mandatory referral 2021M-009AB-001: A request for the abandonment of right-of-way and easements on Baxter Street from Hart Lane to Home Road; requested by Public Works on behalf of Councilmember Nancy VanReece, applicant.

 - d. No parking anytime on both sides of South 5th St from Shelby St to Jerry Newsome Way;
