The renters and owners of that business undertook no efforts to soundproof their property, which is a mere 20 feet from mine at its closest point, nor did they take measures to keep patrons from parking in our shared driveway. I was often able to hear their "business" recording sessions over the television in my house, even with all of the doors and windows closed. I was also unable to park in my own driveway on a number of occasions.
