Your appeal must be filed within 60 days of the date of the entry of the Commission’s decision. We advise that you seek your own independent legal advice to ensure that your appeal is filed in a timely manner and that all procedural requirements have been met.”

- b) Mandatory referral 2021M-014AB-001: A request to authorize the abandonment of an unimproved, unnamed right-of-way off Old Matthews Road. The easement is also proposed to be abandoned, from Old Matthews Road, between 2643 & 2647 Old Matthews Road, northeastward to the dead end, requested by Vickie Vaughn. CD02
