(if applicant rebuts, the opponents may hold 5 minutes for a sur-rebuttal but must address items raised in the rebuttal only)

The hearing is open to anyone who wishes to comment for up to two minutes per person.

The Chair may restrict repetitive comments.

Process for the June 25, 2009 public hearing:

No staff presentation proposed.

Applicant presentation of 15 minutes

(applicant may hold 5 minutes for rebuttal)

Opponents presentation of 15 minutes

(if applicant rebuts, the opponents may hold 5 minutes for a sur-rebuttal but must address items raised in the rebuttal only)

The hearing is open to anyone who wishes to comment on the fiscal component of the SP application for up to two minutes per person. The Chair may restrict repetitive comments.

Action: Approve 8-0
