

#### Goals and Context

The use of armed and sworn officers and exclusionary disciplinary practices are:

- Ineffective at preventing crime and reducing disciplinary referrals
- Disproportionately harmful to Black, Brown and disabled students
- An Inefficient use of city resources

 40% of the MNPS student body are Black students yet they make up 77% of students referred to law enforcement while at school.
