The decisions of the Metropolitan Beer Permit Board take effect on a date to be determined by the board. However, you may file an appeal within 60 days of the date of entry of the board's decision. We advise that you seek your own independent legal advice to ensure that your appeal is filed in a timely manner and that all procedural requirements have been met.

Charges: Violation of M.C.L 7.08.140C

Testimony: Respondent, Copa Cabana Bar & Grill, was represented at the formal hearing by Luis Soto Sanchez. Mr. Sanchez pled not guilty on behalf of the Respondent to the charge of selling beer to a minor (M.C.L. 7.08.140C). At the commencement of the hearing, Beer Board Inspector, Darrell Hardrick, played video footage of the sale to the minor. At the conclusion of the video and board staff testimony, Mr. Sanchez stated that a witness would not be present to testify; therefore, Mr. Sanchez changed the Respondent's plea to guilty.

Board Discussion: Following the guilty plea, the board discussed appropriate punishment. Mr. Spragens made a motion for a \$1500 civil penalty or a 14 day suspension with 90 days probation. The motion was seconded by Ms. Cobb. The board then voted unanimously to adopt Mr. Spragens' motion

M.C.L 7.08.130A It is unlawful for any person To bring, to cause, or allow to be brought onto the premises of any permittee under the provisions of this chapter any prohibited drugs within the meaning of Tennessee Code Annotated, Sections 53-10-101, et seq., and 39-17-401, et seq. M.C.L 7.08.140G It is unlawful for any beer permit holder or his agent or employee To operate a disorderly place.

M.C.L 7.08.140J It is unlawful for any beer permit holder or his agent or employee; To permit boisterous or disorderly conduct on the premises.

M.C.L 7.08.140R It is unlawful for any beer permit holder or his agent or employee; To allow or engage in any criminal activity on the premises.

M.C.L 7.08.150B Revocation, suspension or imposition of a civil penalty may be made where it appears satisfactorily that the premises of any person, firm or corporation holding a beer permit under this chapter are being operated in such manner as to be detrimental to public health, safety and morals.

M.C.L 7.08.220 A permit holder must return his permit to the board

within fifteen days of termination of the business, change in ownership, relocation of the business or change of the businesses name; provided that, regardless of the failure to return a beer permit, a permit shall expire upon termination of the business, change in ownership, relocation of the business or change of the business's name.

M.C.L 7.24.030B1 The following acts or conduct have

been declared contrary to public policy by the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee when such activities take place upon premises licensed by the alcoholic beverage commission, pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated Sections 57-4-101, et seq.; and the same are declared to be against the public policy of the metropolitan government of Nashville and Davidson County, and therefore, no beer permit shall be held at any premises where such contract or acts are permitted To employ, use or allow any person in the sale or service of beer or like alcoholic beverages in or upon the premises of a permittee while such person is unclothed or in such attire, costume or clothing as to expose to view any portion of the female breast below the top of the areola or any portion of the pubic hair, anus, cleft of the buttocks, vulva or genitals.

M.C.L 7.24.030B3 The following acts or conduct have been declared contrary to public policy by the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee when such activities take place upon premises licensed by the alcoholic beverage commission, pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated Sections 57-4-101, et seq.; and the same are declared to be against the public policy of the metropolitan government of Nashville and Davidson County, and therefore, no beer permit shall be held at any premises where such contract or acts are permitted To encourage or permit any person on the premises of a permittee to touch, caress or fondle the breast, buttocks, anus or genitals of any other person

M.C.L 7.24.030C1 No permittee shall permit any person to perform acts of or acts which simulate a. Sexual intercourse, masturbation, sodomy, bestiality, oral copulation, flagellation or any sexual acts which are prohibited by law; b. The touching, caressing or fondling of the breast, buttocks, anus or genitals; c. The displaying of the pubic hair, anus, vulva or genitals.

M.C.L 7.24.030C2 Subject to the provisions of subdivision 1 of this subsection, any entertainer who is employed in whole or in part by the permittee to dance at such permittee's premises shall perform only upon a stage at least eighteen inches above the immediate floor level and removed at least six feet from the nearest patron on or about September 25, 2016 and ongoing).

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: Revocation

Charges: Violation of M.C.L. 7.08.110 (violation of state law); 7.08.130A (allowing prohibited drugs); 7.08.140G (operating disorderly business); 7.08.140J (allowing boisterous or disorderly conduct on premises); 7.08.140R (criminal activity); 7.08.220 (failed to return permit to board within fifteen days of termination of business); 7.24.030B1 (acts contrary to public policy); 7.24.030B3 (acts contrary to public policy); 7.24.030C1 (activities sexual in nature); 7.24.030C2 (activities sexual in nature).

Testimony: Respondent, Medusa Nashville Bar & Lounge, did not appear before the board during this formal hearing. The owner of the business, Anthony Powell, notified board staff that he would not appear for the hearing, and he provided a written statement that he was aware of his right to appear and understood that staff would likely recommend revocation. The only witness to testify was Metro Nashville Police Detective, Michael Collazo. Detective Collazo testified regarding a joint investigation between his MNPD unit, the Beer Board, and the TABC. Detective Collazo informed the board of the significant number of calls regarding this permit holder, as well as the number of homicides connected to that location. The detective also recounted an evening that he and another agent conducted surveillance of the location. They witnessed a patron leave the business and walk to his car, which was located across the street from the business and directly in front of agents' car. The individual then removed a weapon from his car and began shooting in the air.

Board Discussion: Following the detective's testimony, the board discussed the matter. Ms. Jarmon then made a motion to sustain the charges, due to the high number of calls, the related homicides, and the outcome of the joint investigation. The motion was seconded by Ms. Cobb. The board then voted unanimously to approve Ms. Jarmon's motion to sustain the charges. Next, the board discussed the appropriate punishment. Ms. Jarmon made a motion to accept the board's recommendation to revoke the permit, which was then seconded by Ms. Cobb. The board voted unanimously to approve Ms. Jarmon's motion to revoke the permit.
