While the Respondent did not sell beer to the informant, it was determined during a subsequent regulatory inspection that Respondent lacked four (4) documents that were required to be posted. The Respondent testified that he was not present during the inspection, but an employee was present. The Respondent stated the documents were posted on their board, but must have fallen behind the other documents posted. Mr. Perlen asked how many total documents were missing, and he was told that four (4) documents were missing which led to a charge of \$100 per document. Mr. Perlen then made a motion to sustain the citation. That motion was then seconded by Mr. Conway.

The Respondent did admit to the sale, but asked for mercy due to the family health emergency. Mr. Bellamy then made a motion to sustain the citation. That motion was then seconded by Mr. Conway.
