MOTION:

After some discussion, Vice-Chairman Corbitt moved to <u>approve the register report.</u> Seconded by Commissioner North and the Commission approved without objection.

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### DEPARTMENTAL ITEM

#### GENERAL SERVICES

#### (1: Director Nancy Whittemore requested approval of the certification requirements for Master Technician.

Stacy Wall, (position) said the recommended revision is to remove the C1 (Service Consultant) certification requirement. It is not necessary for the Master Technician position and only applies to those that are in the automotive service writer position.

#### MOTION: After much discussion, Vice-Chairman Corbitt moved for <u>approval of the above request as</u> <u>submitted</u>. Seconded by Commissioner North and the Commission approved without objection.

### HUMAN RESOURCES

Human Resources Director Rita Roberts-Turner submits the following for the Commission's consideration and appropriate action:

#### (2: Approval of changes for the Sheriff's Office Departmental Rules and Policies

HR Analyst Seth Waltenbaugh said the Sheriff's Office reviewed approximately 26 departmental rules & policies for clean-up and revision. Of the twenty-six, only ten had significant changes which were discussed with the Commission. The job descriptions were also reviewed by the Metro Legal Department and the Human Resources Department. There was no opposition from SEIU.

#### MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner North moved for <u>approval of the above request as submitted</u>. Seconded by Vice-Chairman Corbitt and the Commission approved without objection.

#### (3: Disgualification from Police Lieutenant Exam – Keith Johnson

Mr. Johnson reported to take the written exam for police lieutenant. He was not listed on the roster but was allowed to take the written exam with the understanding he would only be considered a candidate upon confirmation that he completed or attempted to complete the application on file for the 2012 process.

A letter was sent on July 16, 2012 informing Mr. Johnson there was not an application on file. He appealed his disqualification. When consulting with the vendor and reviewing the facts, there is currently no evidence of his attempting an application for any position after 2010, but the vendor is still investigating. The HR Department does not oppose Mr. Johnson going through the assessment center process with an understanding that if there is no evidence of a timely attempt at making an application, he will be disqualified from further consideration.

#### MOTION:

After much discussion, Commissioner North moved for <u>approval of the above request as</u> <u>submitted</u>. Seconded by Commissioner Allen and the Commission approved without objection.

#### (4: Review of Initial Order – Mable Osemwegie, Police / Grievance

Officer Mable Osemwegie submitted a grievance for IOD on October 24, 2011. On November 4, 2011, the case was sent to the Administrative Procedures Division, Office of the Secretary of State and assigned to Administrative Law Judge Marion Wall. Metro Attorney Jenny Howard represented the Metropolitan Police Department. Officer Mable Osemwegie represented herself.

The case was set to be heard on April 17, 2012 by Judge Wall. After hearing and reviewing information regarding the matter, Administrative Law Judge Marion Wall entered an Initial Order on May 18, 2012 and determined the Metropolitan Police Department's decision to deny the grievance should be upheld.

Metro Attorney Jennifer Cavanaugh was present before the Commission to discuss the case. Ms. Osemwegie was duly notified but did not attend the meeting.

#### MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner North moved <u>to reverse Administrative Law Judge Marion</u> <u>Wall's decision and grant the IOD</u>. Seconded by Commissioner Allen and the Commission approved without objection.

#### (5: Review of Initial Order - Jonathan Smith, Police / 6 Days Suspension & Termination

Officer Jonathan Smith was suspended six (6) days and terminated from the Police Department effective February 10, 2011 for the following violations:

Charge 1: General Order 09-03 Deportment and Personal Appearance – VII: Personal Behavior (B) Adherence to Law; Charge 2: General Order 08-06 "Use of Force" – (A): Adherence to Policy & Rules: Section V, Parameters for Non-Deadly Force; (D) any use of force on subjects who are handcuffed or otherwise in custody is prohibited unless physical resistance must be overcome. Such uses of force must be specifically articulated with an emphasis on why a particular level of force was necessary to obtain compliance.; Charge 3: General Order 09-03, Deportment and Personal Appearance; Section VII, Personal Behavior; (C) Conduct unbecoming an employee of the department and Charge 4: Metro Civil Service Rules – Section 6.7 #11 – Violation of any written rules, policies, or procedures of the department in which the employee is employed.

Officer Smith appealed his six day suspension and termination to the Commission. The case was assigned to Administrative Law Judge Randall LaFevor. Metro Attorney Susan Jones initially represented Metropolitan Government during the hearing but was replaced by Metro Attorney Jennifer Cavanaugh. Attorney John M.L. Brown represented Officer Smith.

The hearing was set for September 29, 2011 but was continued and heard by Judge LaFevor on March 21, 2012. After carefully reviewing the case, Judge LaFevor entered an <u>Initial Order on June 11, 2012</u> <u>Upholding the Police Department's decision to TERMINATE the Grievant's employment and dismissing the appeal</u>.

Metro Attorney Jennifer Cavanaugh and Attorney John M.L. Brown were present before the Commission to discuss the matter.

#### MOTION: After much discussion, Commissioner Sanders moved for <u>approval to Uphold Administrative Law</u> <u>Judge Randall LaFevor's Initial Order as submitted</u>. Seconded by Commissioner Allen and the Commission approved without objection.

#### (6: Review of Initial Order – Doug Johnson, WS / Demotion

Mr. Doug Johnson, Engineering Technician 3, was demoted to Engineering Technician 2 for violating:

Civil Service Rules #1 – Neglect or failure to perform official duty; #2 – Deficient or inefficient performance of duties; #11 – Violation of any written rules, policies or procedures of the department in which the employee is employed; and #32 – Any failure of good behavior which reflects discredit upon himself, the department and/or the Metropolitan Government.

Mr. Johnson appealed his demotion to the Commission and the case was assigned to Administrative law Judge Stephen Darnell. Metro Attorney Jennifer Cavanaugh represented Metropolitan Government. Attorney James King represented Mr. Johnson.

The case was scheduled to be heard on September 12, 2011 but was rescheduled for December 14, 2011. On April 24, 2012, <u>Judge Darnell entered an Initial Order that the Grievant's demotion be UPHELD</u>. A Notice of Petition for Reconsideration of the Initial Order was submitted on May 11, 2012 to Judge Darnell. Judge Darnell sent an Order on May 15, 2012 denying the Grievant's reconsideration.

Metro Attorney Corey Harkey and Attorney James G. King were present before the Commission to review and discuss the case.

MOTION: After much discussion, Vice-Chairman Corbitt moved for <u>approval to Uphold Administrative Law</u> <u>Judge Steve Darnell's Initial Order as submitted</u>. Seconded by Commissioner Allen and the Commission approved without objection.
