MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner North moved to approve the register report. Seconded by Vice-Chairman Corbitt, and the Commission approved without objection.

DEPARTMENTAL ITEMS

CODES ADMINISTRATION

(1: Director Terry Cobb requests approval to hire above base Freddy D. Morgan as an Electrical Inspector 1 at SR09, step 3

Director Terry Cobb and Human Resources Assistant Director Michael Taylor were present before the Commission. Director Cobb said Mr. Morgan had left Codes Administration in 2014 for a family-owned business. Mr. Morgan was fully trained and immediately able to perform his duties, therefore the department requested to rehire him at the same step level where he had been classified when he left.

MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner Sanders moved to approve the request to hire above base the Electrical Inspector 1 at SR09, step 3. Seconded by Commissioner North, and the Commission approved without objection.

(2: Director Terry Cobb requests Leave from Civil Service status for Monica R. Bishop

Director Terry Cobb and Human Resources Assistant Director Michael Taylor remained before the Commission. Director Cobb said Ms. Bishop, a fifteen year Metro Employee, had recently returned to work after the birth of her child and requested to work part-time in order to spend more time with her newborn.

MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner Sanders moved to approve the request for a Leave from Civil Service status. Seconded by Commissioner North, and the Commission approved without objection.

HUMAN RESOURCES

Human Resources Director, Veronica T. Frazier, submits the following for the Commission's consideration and appropriate action:

(3: Review of Agreed Final Order – Alan Miller, Parks Department – Termination

Former Parks Police Officer Alan Miller, his Legal Counsel Daphne Davis, and Metro Attorney Jason Bobo, representing the Parks Department, were present before the Commission to discuss the Agreed Final Order. Mr. Bobo explained the agreement was for the Parks Department to accept Mr. Miller's resignation, and that Mr. Miller would not seek future employment with Metro Government.

MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner North moved to uphold the Administrative Law Judge's Agreed Final Order. Seconded by Vice-Chairman Corbitt, and the Commission approved without objection.

(4: Review of Agreed Order of Dismissal – Cory West, Police Department – Grievance

Police Officer West's Legal Counsel Kim Gilleland, and Metro Attorney Mark Murray, representing the Metro Nashville Police Department, were present before the Commission to discuss the Agreed Order. Mr. Murray explained the settlement was for the Police Department to reinstate Mr. West as a commissioned officer.

MOTION: After some discussion, Vice-Chairman Corbitt moved to uphold the Administrative Law Judge's Agreed Order of Dismissal. Seconded by Commissioner Sanders, and the Commission approved without objection.

(5: Review of Initial Order – Jerry Perigo, Water Department – Termination

Mr. Jerry Perigo, his Legal Counsel Kim Gilleland, and Metro Attorney Tara Ladd, representing the Metro Water Services, were present before the Commission to discuss the Initial Order.

MOTION: After some discussion, Vice-Chairman Corbitt moved to modify the Administrative Law Judge's Initial Order and uphold the termination. Seconded by Commissioner Sanders. Chairman Farmer called for a vote, and the Commission approved without objection as follows: Vice-Chairman Corbitt – Aye; Commissioner North – Aye; Commissioner Sanders – Aye.

(6: Metro Public Works employee, Gerald Wright, is requesting a waiver to extend his IOD time in accordance with Civil Service Rule 4.8 D Period of Compensation

Equipment Operator Gerald Wright, Safety Coordinator Edna Jones, and Human Resources Analyst Jason Lusk were present before the Commission. Mr. Lusk stated Mr. Wright submitted a request to extend his Injury on Duty Leave. He sustained an IOD injury on October 27, 2015 after falling from a work truck. He came back to work and then fell a second time on November 5, 2015. He has undergone rehabilitation. Mr. Wright's IOD time expires on April 20, 2016, and his doctor is requesting an additional 90 days of IOD leave.

MOTION: After some discussion, Vice-Chairman Corbitt moved to approve an additional 90 days of IOD leave. Seconded by Commissioner North, and the Commission approved without objection.

(7: Metro Fire Department employee, James Dean, is requesting a waiver to extend his IOD time in accordance with Civil Service Rule 4.8 D Period of Compensation

Fire Captain James Dean, Fire Union Representative Mark Young , Human Resources Manager Jamie Summers, and Human Resources Analyst Brian Ward were present before the Commission. Mr. Ward stated Captain Dean submitted a request to extend his Injury on Duty Leave which expires on June 1, 2016. Captain Dean will undergo hip replacement surgery on April 26, 2016, and his doctor estimates Captain Dean will return to full duty on June 7, 206, although subject to change depending on the patient's progress. Therefore, the department is requesting a waiver to grant an additional 30 days of IOD leave.

MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner Sanders moved to approve an additional 30 days of IOD leave. Seconded by Commissioner North, and the Commission approved without objection.

(8: Requesting approval to conduct Benefit Board Election for General Government representative on May 19, 2016

Human Resources Analyst Seth Waltenbaugh was present before the Commission.

MOTION: After some discussion, Vice-Chairman Corbitt moved to approve the election to be held May 19, 2016. Seconded by Commissioner North, and the Commission approved without objection.

(9: Civil Service By-Law changes request

Human Resources Assistant Director Michael Taylor was present before the Commission to request an update to Section 2 of the Civil Service By-Laws to reflect policy previously approved by the Commission, make some corrections, and to include a statement regarding the use of the masculine noun or pronoun.

MOTION: After some discussion, Vice-Chairman Corbitt moved to approve the By-Law changes. Seconded by Commissioner North, and the Commission approved without objection.

(10: Final Pay Plan Proposal

Water Services Deputy Director John Kennedy and Human Resources Assistant Director Michael Taylor were before the Commission to discuss some revisions. Water Services Deputy Director Kennedy told the Commission the revisions on the report included the compensation level for Police Lieutenant and whether or not librarians would be on Open Range or Step pay plan. A grade was added to the Police and Fire pay scale to slot the Lieutenant directly between the Sergeant and the Captain, and Human Resources agreed not to move forward with placing librarians in the Open Range pay plan. President of the Fraternal Order of Police Danny Hale came before the Commission to say the FOP was pleased with the revision to the pay plan and requested an across the board pay increase.

Fire Union Representative Mark Young came before the Commission regarding the compression issue. Chairman Farmer explained addressing compression is a step-by-step approach, and the Commission and Human Resources were making steps toward addressing it. Vice Chairman Corbitt said Representative Young had previously stated some of the compression had taken care of itself. Representative Young agreed. Vice Chairman Corbitt added that Human Resources would continue studying and improving the pay plan, but Human Resources and the Unions have been working to get the pay plan to a point where, no matter how many individual issues remain, it can be approved by City Council to benefit the masses.

Commissioner Sanders asked Water Services Deputy Director Kennedy what had been indicated to the librarians in their discussions not to move forward with placing librarians in the Open Range pay plan, and if it satisfied the issue? Water Services Deputy Director Kennedy said the issue was satisfied; however, Human Resources believed librarians would have benefited from being placed in Open Range, but since there was contention Human Resources did not move forward with that at this time.

MOTION: Commissioner North moved to approve the 2017 Pay Plan Proposal. Seconded by Commissioner Sanders. After additional discussion, Chairman Farmer called for a vote, and the Commission approved without objection as follows: Vice-Chairman Corbitt –Aye; Commissioner North –Aye; Commissioner Sanders – Aye.

(11: Job Description changes to be effective July 1, 2016

Human Resources Assistant Director Michael Taylor and Human Resources Analyst Jason Lusk were present before the Commission to discuss job description changes including title and grade changes, collapsed classifications, and job descriptions for newly created classifications.

MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner North moved to approve the Job Description changes. Seconded by Vice-Chairman Corbitt, and the Commission approved without objection.

(12: Request for public hearing on revised Civil Service Rules

Human Resources Assistant Director Michael Taylor and Human Resources Analyst Patrick Kennedy were present before the Commission. Human Resources Assistant Director Taylor said most of the revisions included references made to the Step (ST), Open Range (OR) and Police/Fire (PF) pay scales, as well as clarification on overtime pay calculation, and a request from the Sheriff's Office to make their rule on Holiday Pay more in line with General Government.

MOTION: After some discussion, Vice-Chairman Corbitt moved to approve the request to hold a public hearing for revisions to the Civil Service Rules after the regular meeting on May 10, 2016. Seconded by Commissioner North, and the Commission approved without objection.

(13: Administrative Law Judge Hearing Calendar

Chairman Farmer asked if the report had been submitted to the Administrative Law Judges. Ms. Tullos replied yes. The calendar refers to appeals submitted by Metro employees. As changes occur, updates are made each month in conjunction with the assigned Attorneys at Metro Legal. A copy is then forwarded to the State Administrative Procedures Division wherein the State provides a copy for each Judge to evaluate their case.

(14: Human Resources Updates

Human Resources Director Veronica Frazier announced the Human Resources Department hosts quarterly Human Resources (HR) Coordinator meetings. The next meeting will be in May, and the HR Field Representatives will help HR Coordinators with implementation of the FY2017 Pay Plan.

ACTION: This was for a report only.

(15: Communiqués from the public on pending hearings

There were none.

LATE ITEM:

- (1: Chief Ricky White is requesting job description revisions to the following:
 - Emergency Medical Technician 1 (EMT1)
 - Emergency Medical Technician 2 (EMT2)
 - Paramedic 3

Human Resources Manager Jamie Summers and Human Resources Analyst Brian Ward were present before the Commission. Human Resources Manager Summers explained in order meet the minimum state licensure the EMT1 now included a minimum age requirement. In addition, the State of Tennessee changed their licensing requirements, and in order to maintain a Class A ambulance service the Fire Department must require the Advanced Emergency Medical Technician license for both the EMT 1 and 2. On the Paramedic 3 job description, the Fire Department intends to use these positions as field trainers, therefore five years at the rank of Paramedic 2 has been added to the experience section, in order to avoid qualifying someone who has worked as an EMT at the Fire Department for eight years, but only received a paramedic license within the last few months.

MOTION: After some discussion, Vice-Chairman Corbitt moved to approve the job description revisions. Seconded by Commissioner North, and the Commission approved without objection.
