Human Resources Interim Director, John P. Kennedy, submits the following for the Commission's consideration and appropriate action:

(1: Review of Initial Order – Jason Browning, Fire – Termination

Jason Browning, his representation, Brock Parks, and Jennifer Crim, representing Metro Nashville Fire Department, were present before the Commission to discuss the Initial Order.

MOTION: After some discussion, Vice-Chairman Corbitt moved to uphold the Initial Order. Seconded by Commissioner North, and the Commission approved without objection.

(2: Metro Fire Department employee, Patrick Griffin, is requesting to extend his IOD time in accordance with Civil Service Rule 4.8 D Period of Compensation

Captain Patrick Griffin, Human Resources Manager Jamie Summers, and Human Resources Analyst Brian Ward were present before the Commission to discuss the request.

Applicant QM and Civil Service Medical Examiner Matthew Hine were present before the Commission to discuss the appeal.

MOTION: After some discussion, Vice-Chairman Corbitt moved to approve the appeal. Seconded by Commissioner North, and the Commission approved without objection.

(13: Update - FLSA Exemption Regulations

Human Resources Analysts Leslie Schuster and Jason Lusk were present before the Commission. At the November 2016 meeting, the Commission approved job description revisions to ensure compliance with a new salary threshold as part of previously-announced Federal regulations regarding overtime set to change December 1, 2016. Due to an injunction on November 22, 2016, the Federal regulations did not change. Metro HR asked the Commission if they wanted to maintain the changes or revert to the previous exemption status on the changed job descriptions.

MOTION: After some discussion, Vice-Chairman Corbitt moved to remain in compliance with the current Federal Regulations, but the motion was not seconded. As a result, Metro HR will maintain the new salary threshold approved by the Commission at the November meeting.

(14: Update on the Selection Process for the Appointment of a Permanent Human Resources Director

Water Services Assistant Director Sonny Lyons was present before the Commission. A job announcement was posted December 9 and will remain posted until January 9, 2017.

ACTION: This was for a report only.

(15: Administrative Law Judge Hearing Calendar

Chairman Farmer asked if the report had been submitted to the Administrative Law Judges. Ms. Tullos replied yes. The calendar refers to appeals submitted by Metro employees. As changes occur, updates are made each month in conjunction with the assigned Attorneys at Metro Legal. A copy is then forwarded to the State Administrative Procedures Division wherein the State provides a copy for each Judge to evaluate their case.

ACTION: This was for a report only.

(16: Human Resources Updates

Human Resources has met with and received feedback from Metro Departments and the Unions before initiating work on a new pay plan.

HR Staff raised \$5,692.80 for the Metro Employees Consolidated Charities Campaign.

During the 2017 Benefits Enrollment, HR Benefits Staff mailed 21,340 benefits packets, processed 35, 327 employee/pensioner elections/changes, and received 1,350 forms through the Employee Self Service system.

On Saturday, December 10 staff from every Metro department participated in the first Metro Job Fair coordinated by Metro HR and Mayor's Office Staff. There were approximately 250 attendees applying for over 100 Metro jobs, and attendees also participated in interview and resume writing classes.

The Nashville.gov webpage has a translation function which can be used to translate job postings. The Commission discussed using that tool to notify applicants of translation services for Metro job postings.
