MOTION: After some discussion, Vice-Chairman Corbitt moved to approve the Order of Dismissal. Seconded by Commissioner Sanders, and the Commission approved without objection.

(2: Review of Initial Order – Robert Howse, Police - Grievance

Robert Howse, his representation, Brad Rayson, and Jennifer Crim, representing Metro Nashville Police Department, were present before the Commission to discuss the Initial Order.
