(1: Request for an extension to apply Policy 5.7 C-I, Exempt Overtime Pay (in Emergency Situations) and to designate specific classifications as Exempt Overtime Eligible

MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner North moved to defer the appeal for one month in order for the applicant to provide updated medical information to the Civil Service Medical Examiner. Seconded by Commissioner Link, and the Commission approved without objection.

The calendar refers to appeals submitted by Metro employees. As changes occur, updates are made each month in conjunction with the assigned Attorneys at Metro Legal. A copy is then forwarded to the State Administrative Procedures Division wherein the State provides a copy for each Judge to evaluate their case.

(11: Human Resources Updates

On July 6, Human Resources staff met with a representative from TSU to discuss developing a partnership which could blossom into internships and possible future employment in Metro departments for TSU students.

HR training staff recently began offering training for HR Coordinators to help develop departmental HR staff and increase their human resources knowledge.

HR staff was at the Madison Police Precinct on Thursday, July 27 to record orientation training to inform staff on the promotional processes for Police Captains, Lieutenants, and Sergeants.

HR training staff partnered with Health Department staff to help them attain Defensive Driving trainer certification through the National Safety Council. As a result, the Health Department is now able to offer in-house defensive driving training.
