MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner North moved to approve the register report. Seconded by Commissioner Link, and the Commission approved without objection.

DEPARTMENTAL ITEM

PUBLIC WORKS

- (1: Director Mark Sturtevant requests an Open Range salary increase for the following
 - a. Sharon Smith. Public Works Assistant Director OR 11
 - b. Don Reid, Public Works Assistant Director OR 11

Human Resources Manager Charles Boddie and Human Resources Analyst Monica Anderson were present before the Commission to discuss the request.

Vice-Chairman Corbitt asked for clarification on the difference in proposed salary requests between the two employees. Human Resources Manager Boddie explained that although Ms. Smith had been with Public Works longer, Mr. Reid had been in upper level management for longer.

MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner North moved to approve the request for Open Range salary increases. Seconded by Commissioner Link, and the Commission approved without objection.

HUMAN RESOURCES

Human Resources Director, Shannon B. Hall, submits the following for the Commission's consideration and appropriate action:

(2: Review of Initial Order – Randall Kestner, Public Works - Dismissal

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Tara Ladd, representing Public Works, was present before the Commission to discuss the Initial Order.

MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner North moved to approve the Initial Order. Seconded by Commissioner Link, and the Commission approved without objection.

(3: Review of Initial Order – Gerry Hutcheson, Police – Suspension

Gerry Hutcheson, his representation, Kim Gilleland, and Cynthia Gross, representing Metro Nashville Police Department, were present before the Commission to discuss the Initial Order.

MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner North moved to approve the Initial Order. Seconded by Commissioner Link, and the Commission approved without objection.

(4: Appeal of Medical Disqualification: GB, Applicant for Police Officer Trainee

Applicant GB and Civil Service Medical Examiner Gill Wright were present before the Commission to discuss the appeal. The Civil Service Medical Examiner recommended approval of the appeal.

MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner North moved to approve the appeal for a medical waiver. Seconded by Commissioner Link, and the Commission approved without objection.

(5: Appeal of Medical Disqualification: EG, Applicant for Police Officer Trainee

Applicant EG and Civil Service Medical Examiner Gill Wright were present before the Commission to discuss the appeal. The Civil Service Medical Examiner recommended denial of the appeal.

MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner Link moved to deny the appeal for a medical waiver. Seconded by Commissioner North, and the Commission approved without objection.

(6: Appeal of Medical Disqualification: JS, Applicant for Police Officer Trainee

Civil Service Medical Examiner Gill Wright was present before the Commission to discuss the appeal. The Civil Service Medical Examiner recommended approval of the appeal.

MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner North moved to approve the appeal for a medical waiver. Seconded by Commissioner Link, and the Commission approved without objection.

(7: Metro Fire Department employee, Kristine Bailey, is requesting to extend her IOD time in accordance with Civil Service Rule 4.8 D Period of Compensation

Fire Captain Kristine Bailey, Administrative Services Officer Michele Smith and Human Resources Analyst Brian Ward were present before the Commission to discuss the request.

MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner Link moved to approve the request to extend Ms. Bailey's IOD time 90 days. Seconded by Commissioner North, and the Commission approved without objection.

(8: Grievance Request – Paid Family Leave

Sergeant Jeff Brown and Officer Brian Theriac, their representation, Rachel Thomas, and Cynthia Gross, representing Metro Nashville Police Department, were present before the Commission to discuss the complaint. Ms. Thomas stated, as a preliminary matter, it was her understanding that Ms. Hall was not on the Civil Service Commission.

Vice-Chairman Corbitt stated she's not a member.

Ms. Thomas asked why Ms. Hall was sitting with the Commission during an appeal of her decision.

Vice-Chairman Corbitt stated to answer your question, the Civil Service Commission supervises the HR Director and she's the Secretary to the Civil Service Commission. She is required to sit with the Civil Service Commission during meetings, and that also applies to the Employee Benefit Board. If not her, it would be her designee. Does that answer your question?

Ms. Thomas continued to question Ms. Hall's presence.

Vice-Chairman Corbitt stated her job is to be here. You're asking us to review a decision she made; that's our job.

Ms. Thomas stated for the record that she felt it was unfair for Ms. Hall to sit with the Civil Service Commission during review of the complaint.

ACTION: After some discussion and without objection, the Civil Service Commission deferred this item to the next meeting to be heard before the entire Commission and to allow for all of Ms. Thomas' clients to apply for Paid Family Leave through the Police Department and be advised on the status of those applications.

(9: Civil Service Policy Proposal – 3.1-III Workplace Conduct

Human Resources Analyst Les Bowron was present before the Commission to discuss the policy.

MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner North moved to approve the proposed policy. Seconded by Commissioner Link, and the Commission approved without objection.

(10: Civil Service Policy changes request – 6.1 Substance Abuse Policy

ACTION: This item was deferred to the November 2017 Civil Service Commission Meeting.

(11: Memorandum of Understanding Extension Agreement for Nashville Firefighters and Fire Service Employees Association, Local 140 (IAFF)

Fire Union Representative Mark Young, Administrative Services Officer Michele Smith, and Human Resources Assistant Director Michael Taylor were present before the Commission to discuss the memorandum of understanding (MOU) extension agreement.

MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner Link moved to approve the MOU extension agreement. Seconded by Commissioner North, and the Commission approved without objection.

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(12: Administrative Law Judge Hearing Calendar

The calendar refers to appeals submitted by Metro employees. As changes occur, updates are made each month in conjunction with the assigned Attorneys at Metro Legal. A copy is then forwarded to the State Administrative Procedures Division wherein the State provides a copy for each Judge to evaluate their case.

ACTION: This was for a report only.

(13: Human Resources Updates

During the week of September 18 - 21, Human Resources staff facilitated the MNPD Captain's Assessment Center, and 19 lieutenants successfully completed promotional testing.

HR staff participated in the Cities of Heart Workforce Initiative on September 20, sharing information on the Metro employee benefits program to Metro employees.

On September 26, HR staff coordinated the Mayor's Service Awards Celebration honoring Metro employees who have served our city for 30 years and every five years thereafter.
