DEPARTMENTAL ITEM

PLANNING COMMISSION

(1: Interim Executive Director Robert Leeman requests an Increment Advance for Jason Rust, Planning Technician 3

Special Projects Manager George Rooker, Planning Manager Lucy Kempf, and Human Resources Analyst Monica Anderson were present before the Commission to discuss the request.

MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner North moved to approve the request for an Increment Advance. Seconded by Vice-Chairman Corbitt, and the Commission approved without objection.

HUMAN RESOURCES

Human Resources Director, Shannon B. Hall, submits the following for the Commission's consideration and appropriate action:

(2: Review of Agreed Order of Dismissal – Burnice Gipson, Fire - Dismissal

Mr. Gipson's representation Dewey Branstetter and Cyndi Gross, representing Metro Nashville Fire Department, were present before the Commission to discuss the Agreed Order of Dismissal.

MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner Sanders moved to approve the Agreed Order of Dismissal. Seconded by Commissioner North, and the Commission approved without objection.

(3: Review of Initial Order – Ricky Cox, Library - Dismissal

Quan Poole, representing the Library Department, was present before the Commission to discuss the Initial Order. Mr. Cox self-represented, was duly notified of the meeting, but was not present for the review.

MOTION: After some discussion, Vice-Chairman Corbitt moved to approve the Initial Order and uphold the dismissal. Seconded by Commissioner Sanders, and the Commission approved without objection.

(4: Review of Initial Order – James Tucker, Police - Dismissal

Cyndi Gross, representing the Police Department, was present before the Commission to discuss the Initial Order. Mr. Tucker self-represented, was duly notified of the meeting, but was not present for the review.

MOTION: After some discussion, Vice-Chairman Corbitt moved to approve the Initial Order and uphold the dismissal/suspension. Seconded by Commissioner Sanders, and the Commission approved without objection.

(5: Review of Initial Order – James Green, Water - Dismissal

Mr. Green, his representation Russell Freeman, and Tara Ladd, representing Water Department, were present before the Commission to discuss the Initial Order.

1st MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner Sanders moved to reverse the Initial Order's finding on the charge of discrimination for the reasons set forth in the appeal by Metro Government and instead find that Mr. Green violated Civil Service Rule 6.7 #30. Seconded by Commissioner North, and the Commission approved with objection as follows: Vice-Chairman Corbitt – Nay; Commissioner North – Aye; Commissioner Sanders - Aye.

2nd MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner Sanders moved to reverse the Initial Order's finding to return Mr. Green to work for the reasons set forth in the appeal by Metro Government and instead allow Mr. Green to resign. The motion failed for lack of a second.

3rd MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner Sanders moved as follows: (i) to reverse the Initial Order's

finding on the charge of discrimination for the reasons set forth in the appeal by Metro Government; (ii) to impose a ten day suspension for violation of Civil Service Rule 6.7 #24; (iii) to impose a ten day suspension for violation of Civil Service Rule 6.7 #33; and (iv) to impose a suspension commencing on the date of Mr. Green's termination and ending on the date of the Commission's April 10, 2018 review of the Initial Order for violation of Civil Service Rule 6.7 #30 and to return Mr. Green to work without backpay. Seconded by Commissioner North, and the Commission approved as follows: Vice-Chairman Corbitt – Abstained; Commissioner North – Aye; Commissioner Sanders - Aye.

Mr. Freeman and Ms. Ladd were asked to submit proposed Final Orders, based on the preceding motions, to the Commission for review and final approval at the May 8, 2018 Civil Service Commission Meeting.

(6: Metro Police Department employee, Daniel Alford, is requesting to extend his IOD time in accordance with Civil Service Rule 4.8 D Period of Compensation

Daniel Alford and Human Resources Analyst Seth Waltenbaugh were present before the Commission to discuss the request.

MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner North moved to approve the request to extend Mr. Alford's IOD time an additional 90 days. Seconded by Vice-Chairman Corbitt, and the Commission approved without objection.

(7: Appeal of Medical Disqualification: RB, Applicant for Police Officer Trainee

Applicant RB and Civil Service Medical Examiner Gill Wright were present before the Commission to discuss the appeal. The Civil Service Medical Examiner recommended approval of the appeal.

MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner North moved to approve the request for a waiver. Seconded by Vice-Chairman Corbitt, and the Commission approved without objection.

(8: Appeal of Medical Disqualification: SD, Applicant for Police Officer Trainee

Applicant SD and Civil Service Medical Examiner Gill Wright were present before the Commission to discuss the appeal. The Civil Service Medical Examiner recommended approval of the appeal.

MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner Sanders moved to approve the request for a waiver. Seconded by Commissioner North, and the Commission approved without objection.

(9: Appeal of Medical Disqualification: AE, Applicant for Police Officer Trainee

Civil Service Medical Examiner Gill Wright was present before the Commission to discuss the appeal. The Civil Service Medical Examiner recommended approval of the appeal.

MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner North moved to approve the request for a waiver. Seconded by Vice-Chairman Corbitt, and the Commission approved without objection.

(10: Appeal of Medical Disqualification: CF, Applicant for Police Officer Trainee

ACTION: This item was withdrawn.

(11: Appeal of Medical Disqualification: CH, Applicant for Police Officer Trainee

Applicant CH and Civil Service Medical Examiner Gill Wright were present before the Commission to discuss the appeal. The Civil Service Medical Examiner recommended approval of the appeal.

MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner North moved to approve the request for a waiver. Seconded by Vice-Chairman Corbitt, and the Commission approved without objection.

(12: Appeal of Medical Disqualification: TH, Applicant for Police Officer Trainee

Civil Service Medical Examiner Gill Wright was present before the Commission to discuss the appeal. The Civil Service Medical Examiner recommended denial of the appeal.

MOTION: After some discussion, Vice-Chairman Corbitt moved to deny the request for a waiver. Seconded by Commissioner North, and the Commission approved without objection.

(13: Appeal of Medical Disqualification: RL, Applicant for Police Officer Trainee

Applicant RL and Civil Service Medical Examiner Gill Wright were present before the Commission to discuss the appeal. The Civil Service Medical Examiner recommended approval of the appeal.

MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner North moved to approve the request for a waiver. Seconded by Vice-Chairman Corbitt, and the Commission approved without objection.

(14: Appeal of Medical Disqualification: AS, Applicant for Police Officer Trainee

Civil Service Medical Examiner Gill Wright was present before the Commission to discuss the appeal. The Civil Service Medical Examiner recommended approval of the appeal.

MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner North moved to approve the request for a waiver. Seconded by Commissioner Sanders, and the Commission approved without objection.

(15: Request for Public Hearing on revised Civil Service Rules

Human Resources Administrator Mary Emigh was present before the Commission to discuss the request for revisions to Civil Service Rules Sections 2.2, 2.4, 2.10, 2.13, and 5.7.

MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner North moved to hold a public hearing on May 8, 2018 for revisions to the Civil Service Rules. Seconded by Commissioner Sanders, and the Commission approved without objection.

(16: Administrative Law Judge Hearing Calendar

The calendar refers to appeals submitted by Metro employees. As changes occur, updates are made each month in conjunction with the assigned Attorneys at Metro Legal. A copy is then forwarded to the State Administrative Procedures Division wherein the State provides a copy for each Judge to evaluate their case.

(17: Human Resources Updates

On Wednesday, March 14, Metro's Drug Free Workplace Program vendor notified Metro they were closing their doors in 2 days.

- Metro HR reached out to a previous, well-respected vendor, Workforce Essentials, for assistance during this time.
- Arrangements were made by HR and Procurement to secure services for that approaching weekend.
- We are currently in the process of finalizing a 2 year emergency contract.

On March 19, Human Resources presented a data-driven budget presentation to the Mayor for the upcoming fiscal year.

That same day, HR staff partnered with the Mayor's Office and coordinated a Postsecondary Education Fair, including information on Metro's tuition reimbursement program and earning a GED, for Metro Employees.

HR staff participated in the Workforce Essentials Spring College and Career Fair for students and adults seeking employment on March 21 at Bass Learning Center.

Human Resources welcomes two new HR Analysts, Wyntress Patterson for Employee Relations and Russ Posten for Talent Acquisition.
