MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner North moved to approve the register report. Seconded by Commissioner Sanders, and the Commission approved without objection.

HUMAN RESOURCES

Human Resources Director, Shannon B. Hall, submits the following for the Commission's consideration and appropriate action:

(1: Review of Initial Order - Michael McKeon, Parks - Dismissal

Michael McKeon and Metro Legal Attorney Jason Bobo, representing the Parks Department, were before the Commission to discuss the order.

MOTION: After some discussion, Vice-Chairman Corbitt moved to Uphold the Initial Order. Seconded by Commissioner Sanders, and the Commission approved with objection as follows: Vice-Chairman Corbitt – Aye; Commissioner Link – Nay; Commissioner North – Aye; Commissioner Sanders – Aye.

(2: Review of Agreed Final Order - John Nicholson, MNPD - Suspension

Officer John Nicholson, his representation Kim Gilleland, and Metro Legal Attorney Jason Bobo, representing the Police Department, were before the Commission to discuss the agreed order.

MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner North moved to approve the Agreed Final Order. Seconded by Vice-Chairman Corbitt, and the Commission approved without objection.

- (3: Review of Initial Order David Terrazas, Police Suspension/Dismissal
 - Mr. Terrazas' representation Kim Gilleland, and Cyndi Gross, representing the Police Department, were before the Commission to discuss the Initial Order. They were later joined by Human Resources Analyst Seth Waltenbaugh.
- MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner Sanders moved (i) to amend the Initial Order findings to state Equibolin was an immediate precursor to a controlled substance and Officer Terrazas violated the Substance Abuse Policy, as substantiated by expert testimony during the hearing before the Administrative Law Judge, (ii) to maintain the Initial Order's 4-day suspension for Officer Terrazas' nonwork related use of MNPD's electronic databases, and (iii) to impose a suspension commencing on the date of Officer Terrazas' dismissal and ending on the date of the Commission's July 10, 2018 review of the Initial Order for violation of the Substance Abuse Policy. Seconded by Commissioner Link, and the Commission approved without objection.
- (4: Metro Fire Department employee, Darryl Stevens, is requesting to extend his IOD time in accordance with Civil Service Rule 4.8 D Period of Compensation

Fire Department Human Resources Manager Jamie Summers was before the Commission to discuss the request.

- MOTION: After some discussion, Vice-Chairman Corbitt moved to approve the request to extend Mr. Stevens' IOD time through October 1, 2018. Seconded by Commissioner North, and the Commission approved without objection.
- (5: Davidson County Sheriff's Office employee, Cody Latham, is requesting to extend his IOD time in accordance with Civil Service Rule 4.8 D Period of Compensation

Cody Latham and Human Resources Analyst Seth Waltenbaugh were before the Commission to discuss the request.

- MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner North moved to approve the request to extend Mr. Latham's IOD time through September 24, 2018. Seconded by Commissioner Link, and the Commission approved without objection.
- (6: Appeal of Medical Disqualification: JC, Applicant for Police Officer Trainee

Applicant JC and Civil Service Medical Examiner Gill Wright were before the Commission to discuss the appeal. The Civil Service Medical Examiner recommended approval of the appeal.

- MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner Link moved to approve the request for a waiver. Seconded by Commissioner North, and the Commission approved without objection.
- (7: Appeal of Medical Disqualification: HD, Applicant for Police Officer Trainee

Applicant HD and Civil Service Medical Examiner Gill Wright were before the Commission to discuss the appeal. The Civil Service Medical Examiner recommended approval of the appeal.

- MOTION: After some discussion, Commissioner North moved to approve the request for a waiver. Seconded by Commissioner Link, and the Commission approved without objection.
- (8: Appeal of Medical Disqualification: CK, Applicant for Police Officer Trainee

Civil Service Medical Examiner Gill Wright was before the Commission to discuss the appeal. The Civil Service Medical Examiner recommended denial of the appeal.

MOTION: After some discussion, Vice-Chairman Corbitt moved to deny the request for a waiver. Seconded by Commissioner North, and the Commission approved without objection.

(9: Report of an Approved Departmental Layoff Plan for Information Technology Services

Assistant Director Michael Taylor was before the Commission to discuss the plan, and was later joined by ITS Assistant Director Cyndy Maddox.

(10: Approval of a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County and the Fraternal Order of Police

President James Smallwood and Assistant Director Michael Taylor were before the Commission to discuss the MOU.

MOTION: After some discussion, Vice-Chairman Corbitt moved to approve the Memorandum of Understanding. Seconded by Commissioner Sanders, and the Commission approved without objection.

(11: Administrative Law Judge Hearing Calendar

The calendar refers to appeals submitted by Metro employees. As changes occur, updates are made each month in conjunction with the assigned Attorneys at Metro Legal. A copy is then forwarded to the State Administrative Procedures Division wherein the State provides a copy for each Judge to evaluate their case.
