# DAVIDSON COUNTY ELECTION COMMISSION

## February 8, 2017

The Davidson County Election Commission (DCEC) met on February 8, 2017 at 4:00 p.m. in the Antioch Conference Room at Metro Southeast. Commissioners Jim DeLanis, A.J. Starling, Tricia Herzfeld, Jesse Neil and Jennifer Lawson were present. DCEC staff members present included: Administrator of Elections (AOE) Jeff Roberts, Joan Nixon, Jeremy Greene, Bobby Medley, Reid Lovell, Rick Brown, Lisa Pierce, and Kelley Harrison. Also present were Nicki Eke and Lora Fox of the Metropolitan Department of Law.

Chairman DeLanis convened the meeting.

## Approve Minutes From November 28, 2016 Meeting

## **Executive Session**

The Commission recessed for a brief Executive Session to meet with legal Counsel concerning threatened litigation.

## **Budget Discussion**

AOE Roberts presented the Commission with a five (5) page document titled "Election Commission at a glance FY'17". AOE Roberts gave a synopsis of the proposed DCEC budget. The DCEC will propose the following improvements to be presented before Metro Council:

- 1. \$8,000 Electronic Financial Disclosure Software
- 2. The DCEC will request \$40,000 for new electronic filing system in the file room from Metro's 4% pool for large equipment purchases.
- 3. \$5.5 million dollars in FY '18-'19 to replace current voting machines, data base, poll books etc. About \$2 million of that total is to be funded by the State.

DCEC part-time employees will be made full-time with the funds from a vacant position. Metro HR suggested the Commission take action and create a title called "Election Commission Clerk." Discussion ensued among the Commission.

**Motion stated**: Commissioner Herzfeld made a motion to create a position designated Election Commission Clerk.

Seconded by: Commissioner Lawson

Outcome of motion: Passed unanimously

Motion stated: Commissioner Herzfeld made a motion to approve the proposed DCEC budget. Seconded by: Commissioner Lawson Outcome of motion: Passed unanimously

## HR Issues and HR Manual Update

HR Issue: Election Commission Clerk – Commission handled this agenda item as set forth above.
HR Manual Update: AOE Roberts would like to compare DCEC HR Manual and Metro HR Manual for any standard policy updates.

Commissioner Herzfeld would like to submit revisions to the "Speak- Up Policy" to make it more user friendly.

Commissioner Starling suggested an Employee Retreat including the Commission.

## AOE Report

AOE reported the following:

- •Two pieces of legislation (1) Poll Officials must be approved ninety (90) days before an election instead of sixty (60) days; (2) Absentee Ballot requests will now request only the last four (4) digits of the social security number instead of the full social security number

Commissioner Starling wanted to publicly thank the Secretary of State's office and the DCEC office in dispelling any rumors of tampering with voting machines during the November election.
