

# Davidson County Election Commission

**May 10, 2018**

The Davidson County Election Commission (DCEC) met on May 10, 2018 at 3:30 p.m. in the Antioch Conference Room at Metro Southeast. Chairman DeLanis, AJ Starling, Tricia Herzfeld, Jesse Neil and Emily Reynolds were present. DCEC staff members present included: Administrator of Elections (AOE) Jeff Roberts, Joan Nixon, Carlatina Hampton, Bobby Medley, Lisa Pierce, Courtney Mott and Kelley Harrison. Also present were Nicki Eke and Lora Fox, of the Metropolitan Department of Law.
