- I. After today's meeting the Clerk will issue a Notice for Public Comment with a response deadline of September 15, 2020.
- II. The next Board meeting will take place on September 21 at a time to be determined. This meeting will be to conduct a public hearing and to review any public comments submitted for consideration of the materials the Board intends to develop as manuals and regulations for the Lobbyist Code.
- III. A subsequent meeting will take place on October 12 to discuss the materials being developed.

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- IV. Another meeting will take place on October 26 in order to review the first formal draft of documents, including both the materials developed by the Board as well as the forms developed by the Clerk's Office. The Board-initiated materials will be publicly posted for public comments.
- V. A meeting will be held on November 23, at which the public comments will be considered and revisions to the materials may be discussed.
- VI. A meeting is tentatively scheduled on December 14 in the event any pending items continue to be in need of revision.
