Code Provision: The 2012 IECC section C-403.3.1 Economizers states that each cooling system that has a fan shall include either an air or water economizer meeting the requirements of Sections C403.3.1.1 through C403.3.1.1.4.

Variance Requested: Due to historical concerns and documentation from the mechanical engineer, the building owner requests waiving the requirement for economizers on HVAC systems for all tenants.

Code Provision: The IMC 403.3 Outdoor airflow rate. Ventilation systems shall be designed to have the capacity to supply the minimum outdoor airflow rate determined in accordance with this section. The occupant load utilized for design of the ventilation system shall not be less than the number determined from the estimated maximum occupant load rate identified in Table 403.3. For Nail salons, footnote b to table 403.3 requires mechanical exhaust and prohibits the recirculation of air. Footnote h requires each nail station to be provided with a source capture system capable of exhausting not less than 50 cfm per station.

Variance Requested: Appellant appeals the requirement for a source capture exhaust system at each nail station.

NOTES: Renovations to 2200 SF shell space for a Business occupancy for Cured Nails, a nail salon per Permit # 2017067519.
