 - iii. Can the higher functioning organizations apply as well? No limitations on experience, expertise, etc.

- x. Adding in Diversity section in the application, question for Commission if there should be additional points for minority contracting?

- c. Spring Innovation Pool of Funds
 - i. Clarify proof of loan commitments: Loan commitment without term requirements (for example, interest rate, 15 year terms); Allow pre-approval letter and loan commitment (including \$ amount)
 - ii. Cash flow: Add scoring for cash flow throughout the life of the project (positive cash flow)—5 points
 - iii. Diversity: only gathering information not scoring for this
 - iv. Clearly label threshold criteria
 - v. Previous rounds: if awarded funds in previous rounds and are not on your timeline for drawing down funds and/or construction, negative points for project (do not want funding sitting there)
 - vi. Set aside for Fall 2016 applicants who were not awarded funds: Staff could review updated information and bring back the information, Grade old criteria with staff review, Can also submit an application
 - vii. Limit applications: set aside will have separate criteria, commission can decide on maximum awards, two organizations were partially funded and they can reapply in this round and get partial funding for set aside and full funding for main innovation pool, applicants can submit up to two applications total for spring round
 - viii. Add a small dollar pool for the fall round
