- III. Monthly Financial Report: Staff presented the monthly financial report provided by Finance which included funds dispersed for grant draws and legal fees to cover the deed work for the community land trust.

- a. Spring 2019 Round Awards Review-
 - Conflict of Interest declarations: Amos shared the process for the commission's declaration of any conflict of interest. All conflicts were recorded on a signed document.
 - ii. Vote: Schmitz announced the 7 grant awardees: Woodbine, Urban Housing Solutions, Habitat for Humanity, Rebuilding Together Nashville, Renewal House, Crossbridge, and Affordable Housing Resources. Schmitz shared the process the committee underwent in analyzing the scoring. There was strong consensus on the top applicants and this made the committee's decision cohesive. The chair shared that there were roughly \$17m in projects and the total applicant pool was extremely strong. Davis read the addresses of the back-tax property that was awarded to Affordable Housing Solutions and the districts and addresses of the projects. After discussion by the commission, a vote was taken and unanimously approved the award recommendations.
