- 11-21-04 Request for conditional approval to accept a donation from Habitat for Humanity, of 2 tracts of land totaling 1.47-acres and proposed park improvements to the land. Tract One is a 1.14-acre portion of Parcel ID# 06000005700 located at 3017 Aldrich Lane. Tract Two is a 0.33-acre portion of Parcel ID# 06000008900 located at 520 Brick Church Park Drive. Conditions include:
  - Parks staff-level approval of all design, construction and compliance with all Metro Parks standards and policies
  - · Coordinated public engagement during design phase
  - A Phase One environmental review of all property to be donated and resolution of any required remediation
  - Development of property survey, legal description and all other instruments required per Metro to accept the property donation
  - Standard written confirmation of other terms including no match obligation from Parks.
  - Upon transfer, Metro Parks will operate and maintain the park.
- 11-21-05 A lease amendment is requested for the property located at 7820 Coley Davis, Parcel ID# 14100007400 that Metro leases (and subleases) from the State of Tennessee Department of Transportation. The current lease with TDOT expires on December 31, 2037. Metro has a need for a new mobile emissions testing site in the Bellevue area and requests the Park Board's approval of an amendment to the lease with TDOT to allow the site to be utilized for this purpose.

#### VIII. NEW BUSINESS

12-21-03 The Nashville Zoo, Inc. requests a recommendation of approval from the Park Board to donate a 4.4-acre parcel of property, Parcel # 13300014500, to the Metropolitan Government, as described in Exhibit 1 of the attached Quitclaim Deed. The parcel is adjacent to a parcel of property currently owned by Metro and leased to the Nashville Zoo in a lease agreement approved by BL 096-473 and amended by Resolution R98-1039, attached. A proposed parking garage may be constructed across both of these parcels and the current lease would be amended to include the donated parcel.

## VIII. NEW BUSINESS (con't)

- **12-21-04** Creative Parks Nashville requests the Park Board to accept an in-kind grant not to exceed \$2,975.00 to purchase and install a historical marker near the Centennial Art Center to acknowledge the facility as the former swimming pool. This grant requires no match or other obligation of Metro and Parks.
- **12-21-05** Metro Parks staff requests to adopt the name "Two Rivers Lane" for the internal road in Two Rivers Park to improve public wayfinding. The road provides access to the golf course, dog park, rear parking at McGavock High and secondary access to Two Rivers Middle schools.
- 12-21-06 Centennial Park Conservancy requests the Board to accept an in-kind grant to fund the purchase and installation of flooring in the Parthenon's West Gallery and replace the signage at the Parthenon's entrance. This grant will not exceed \$6,811.00 and requires no match or other obligation for Metro Parks. All projects will be paid for directly by Centennial Park Conservancy.
- 12-21-07 Centennial Park Conservancy requests the Board to accept a grant in the amount of \$16,642.00 to fund one part-time position in the Parthenon Museum store. This grant will be submitted annually and distributed quarterly to Metro Parks. Salaries and actual hours worked will be reflected in quarterly reimbursements. This grant requires no match or other obligation for Metro and Parks.
- 12-21-08 Greenways for Nashville requests the board to accept an in-kind grant to improve trailheads on the Stones River Greenway and 3 trailheads on the Whites Creek Greenway. Improvements include painting, retrofit framing, updated wayfinding graphics, bench repairs and other enhancements to bring the trailheads to like new condition. The value of this grant is \$75,000.00 and requires no match or obligation from Metro Parks. All work will meet Metro Parks specifications and will be paid for by Greenways for Nashville.
- **12-21-09** The Historic Germantown Neighborhood Association requests board approval to fundraise for a proposed fitness trail in the open field in Morgan Park.
