I. CALL TO ORDER

Meeting was called to order at 8:15 a.m.

II. <u>APPROVAL OF OCTOBER 5, 2017 MEETING MINUTES & DECISION</u> LETTERS

After discussion during the Executive Session of the Committee on November 2, 2017 and review of the information presented, Mr. Roy Dale made a motion to approve the proposal with the following standard Conditions #1-2 and Condition # 3. Ms. Anna Maddox seconded the motion. Ms. Ronette Adams-Taylor, Mr. Dale, Mr. Dobb Galbreath, Ms. Debra Grimes, and Ms. Maddox voted in favor of the motion. The motion carried.

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- 1. This variance will expire on November 2, 2018. However, if a Grading Permit, Stormwater Single Family Permit, or Building Permit is issued within that period, the variance expiration date will run concurrent with that permit expiration date. The variance is valid only so long as the plan presented to the Stormwater Management Committee does not change.
- 2. The Appellant shall have the landscaper who installs the required mitigation plantings to certify to MWS Stormwater NPDES Office, in writing (referencing Variance #201700025), once plantings are installed per approved variance plans, and again once plantings have been found to meet a two full growing season requirement. The owner shall maintain a minimum of 75 percent survivability of plantings through two full growing seasons.
- 3. The Appellant provides treatment for the dog park in addition to the mitigation presented.

The committee agreed conditions were met from October 5, 2017 Stormwater Management Committee variance meeting in which the case was deferred. Conditions were:

- 1. The Appellant submitted data showing the stream would not be impacted by the development.
- 2. The Appellant developed a new design, which eliminated the previously requested buffer disturbance.

- 2. The Appellant shall have the landscaper who installs the required mitigation plantings to certify to MWS Stormwater NPDES Office, in writing (referencing Variance #201700028), once plantings are installed per approved variance plans, and again once plantings have been found to meet a two full growing season requirement. The owner shall maintain a minimum of 75 percent survivability of plantings through two full growing seasons.
- 3. The Appellant must provide a method for adjacent properties to convey runoff to the MS4.
- 4. Pipe to extend to the south so that property can hook to new storm system.
