

MEETING MINUTES
OF THE
TRAFFIC AND PARKING COMMISSION
JUNE 8, 2020

The regular monthly meeting of the Traffic and Parking Commission was held at 3:00 p.m., on Monday, June 8, 2020, via WebEx.

CALL TO ORDER

Chairman John Green mentioned ordinance No. BL2006-1050 regarding the appeals process of the Traffic and Parking Commission.

"If you are not satisfied with a decision made by the Traffic & Parking Commission, you may appeal the decision by filing for a writ of certiorari with the Davidson County Chancery or Circuit Court. Your appeal must be filed within 60 days of the date of the entry of the Commission's decision. We advise that you seek your own independent legal advice to ensure that your appeal is filed in a timely manner and that all procedural requirements have been met."

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Commissioner Woods moved to approve the agenda and Council Member O'Connell seconded the motion. All in favor, **no opposition.**

2. **CD19:** Appeal for re-evaluation of existing one-hour parking time limit on the south side of Harrison St. between 3rd Ave. N. and Criddle St.; requested by resident.

Motion was made by CM O'Connell to indefinitely defer and seconded by Commissioner Woods.

All in favor, no opposition.

3. **CD24:** Authorize No Parking on 42nd Av N from Charlotte to Alabama Av; req by Ragan Smith Associates

This item was removed by Chip Knauf from the consent agenda and he requested an indefinite deferral on this item. Motion was made by CM O'Connell and seconded by Commissioner Woods to defer.

All in favor, no opposition.

4. **CD24:** Authorize all way stop at 42nd Av N and Alabama Av; requested by Ragan Smith Associates

This item was removed by Chip Knauf from the consent agenda and he requested an indefinite deferral on this item. Motion was made by CM O'Connell and seconded by Commissioner Woods to defer.

Metropolitan Nashville/Davidson County, Tennessee, and that a certified copy be filed with the Chief of
Police of the Metropolitan Police Department, and that a certified copy be filed with the Metropolitan clerk,
and that said Resolution take effect five (5) days thereafter.
