Your appeal must be filed within 60 days of the date of the entry of the Commission’s decision. We advise that you seek your own independent legal advice to ensure that your appeal is filed in a timely manner and that all procedural requirements have been met.”

- 3) CD19: Authorize the conversion of 4<sup>th</sup> Av S, from KVB to Peabody Street, from 2 way to 1 way southbound. Note: this is a change in records only; requested by Daniel Gore, The Pizzuti Companies
- 4) CD19: A request to authorize 7 metered parking spaces at 600 12<sup>th</sup> Av S; requested by Metro Public Works
