



- · Participate in annual reviews and updates as required.
- On-Site visits



### **DBE Bid Evaluation**

- Procurement Non-Discrimination Program
  - Contact at least three (3) Minority or Women owned business
- Good Faith Effort
- Signed Affidavit with proof of outreach

Required

- SBE Incentive
  - Receive evaluation points for commitment
  - Small and Service Disabled Veteran businesses only
  - Prime Bidder can receive points if qualified as SBE/SDVBE
