TRAFFIC ENGINEERING STAFF REPORT FOR THE TRAFFIC AND PARKING COMMISSION

NEW BUSINESS ITEM # 1 - Proposal #2012M-002AB-001

Request to abandon a portion of Elm Hill Pike (easements and utilities to be retained) from the intersection of Elm Hill Pike with Murfreesboro Pike eastward approximately 460 feet to a proposed new right-of-way.

Requested By: Dale and Associates, applicant Purity Dairies, abutting owner.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

The staff is recommending approval.

DISCUSSION

Elm Hill Pike from the intersection of Murfreesboro Pike eastward approximately 460 feet to a proposed new right-of-way is paved and is used for access to private properties. Metro Public Works has no plans to utilize this land for traffic purposes.

COUNCIL BILL STATUS

A Council Bill has not been filed for the February 7, 2012 Metro Council meeting date. The Planning Department administratively approved this mandatory referral on January 23, 2012.
