Chairperson Gene Ward called the meeting of May 14, 2012 to order at 3:00 p.m.

# CALL TO ORDER

Chairperson Gene Ward mentioned Ordinance No. BL2006-1050 regarding the appeals process of the Traffic and Parking Commission.

"If you are not satisfied with a decision made by the Traffic & Parking Commission, you may appeal the decision by filing for a writ of certiorari with the Davidson County Chancery or Circuit Court. Your appeal must be filed within 60 days of the date of the entry of the Commission's decision. We advise that you seek your own independent legal advice to ensure that your appeal is filed in a timely manner and that all procedural requirements have been met."

# APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Rev. Mitchell moved for approval of the April 9, 2012 Minutes and seconded by Ms. Sanderson and approved by voice vote with no opposition.

## **APPEALS**

1. Request to appeal the denial the installation of an all way stop at Brewer Dr. at Westcrest Drive. Requested by Council Member Davette Blalock, District 27.

Mr. Knauf stated that the denial was based on the traffic volumes and they did not meet the minimum requirement to install the all way stop.

Council Member Davette Blalock stated that this is a major cut through and when the high school dismisses the students fly through this area. She said that this is a long street and people drive way to fast. She noted that there have been several request for this stop sign and she could get a petition if needed.

Council Member Frank Harrison made a motion to **approve**, seconded by Mr. Turner and **approved with no opposition.**
