A Council Bill has not been filed for the July 3, 2012 Metro Council meeting date. The Planning Department administratively approved this mandatory referral on June 26, 2012.

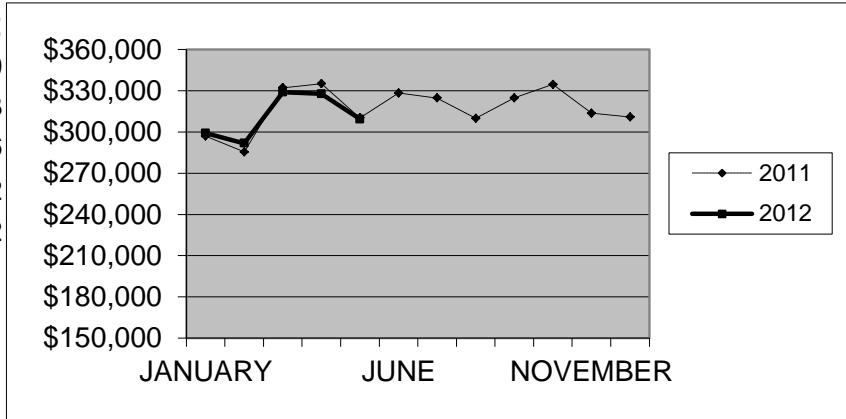

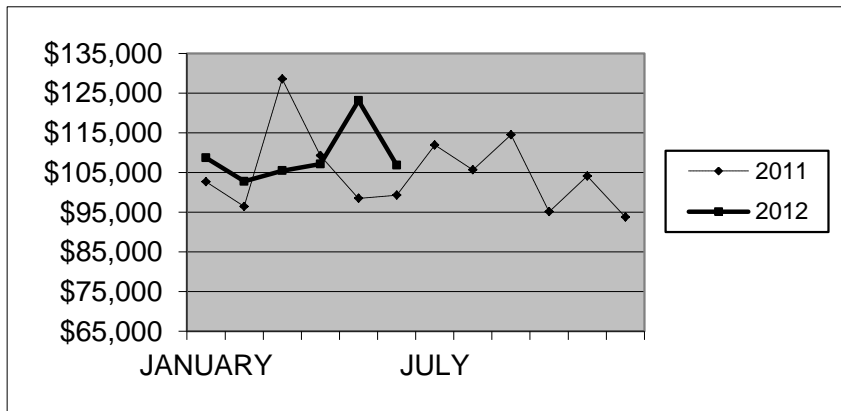
