Chairperson Gene Ward called the meeting of August 13, 2012 to order at 3:00 p.m.

CALL TO ORDER

Chairperson Gene Ward mentioned Ordinance No. BL2006-1050 regarding the appeals process of the Traffic and Parking Commission.

"If you are not satisfied with a decision made by the Traffic & Parking Commission, you may appeal the decision by filing for a writ of certiorari with the Davidson County Chancery or Circuit Court. Your appeal must be filed within 60 days of the date of the entry of the Commission's decision. We advise that you seek your own independent legal advice to ensure that your appeal is filed in a timely manner and that all procedural requirements have been met."

1. Request to appeal the denial of a traffic signal at Buena Vista Pike and Stokers Lane. Requested by Council Member Frank Harrison, District 2.

Council Member Harrison requested an indefinite deferral on this item. He noted that he would prefer to see an all way stop rather than a traffic signal.

Rev. Mitchell motioned for **approval**, seconded by Mr. Green.

2. Request to appeal the denial of an all way stop at Brewer Drive and Wessex Drive. Requested by Council Member Davette Blalock, District 27.

Council Member Davette Blalock stated that cars still drive way to fast down this road and use it to cut through. She stated that the residents are concerned that a child will get hurt walking to school.

Council Member Harrison requested a deferral and request that Council Member Blalock get a petition from the residents in favor of the all way stop.
