STAFF RECOMMENDATION

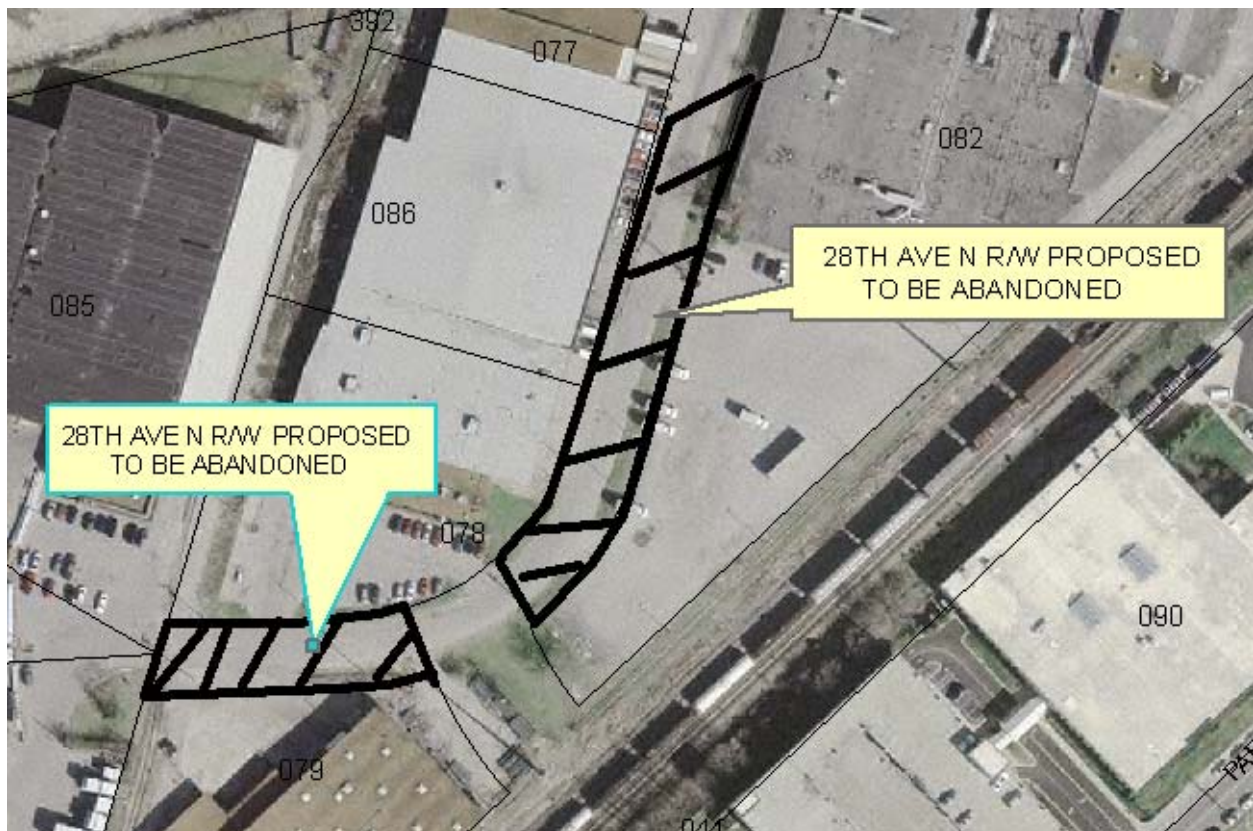
The staff is recommending approval.

DISCUSSION

The excess portion of 28th Avenue North is partially paved and is used by adjacent property owners. Metro Public Works has no plans to utilize this land for traffic purposes.

COUNCIL BILL STATUS

A Council Bill Ordinance No. BL2013-430 has been filed for 28th Avenue North and will be on second reading on May 7, 2013, Metro Council meeting. The Planning Department administratively approved this mandatory referral on April 4, 2013.

A request to abandon the terminus of Adair Road (easements to be retained) from Larimore Drive to Atrium Way.

DISCUSSION

Adair Road from Larimore Drive to Atrium Way is paved and is used by adjacent property owners. Metro Public Works has no plans to utilize this land for traffic purposes.

NEW BUSINESS ITEM #4- Proposal #2013M-010AB-001

A request to abandon a portion of Alley #63 (only stormwater easements to be retained) from Rosa Parks L. Parks Boulevard Eastward to its intersection with Polk Alley between properties located at 700 Broadway and 126 Rosa Parks Boulevard.

Requested By: Requested by the Kline, Sweeney & Associates, applicant. Council District, 19

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

The staff is recommending approval.

Nashville Electric Service (NES) is recommending disapproval at this time.

DISCUSSION

Alley #63 from Rosa L. Parks Boulevard to Polk Alley is paved and is used by adjacent property owners. Metro Public Works has no plans to utilize this land for traffic purposes.

COUNCIL BILL STATUS

A Council Bill has not been filed for the May 7, 2013 Metro Council meeting date. Since NES is recommending disapproval, the Planning Department will not administratively approve this mandatory referral at this time.
