Chairman Feller Brown called the meeting of February 09, 2015 to order at 3:00 p.m.

CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Brown mentioned Ordinance No. BL2006-1050 regarding the appeals process of the Traffic and Parking Commission.

“If you are not satisfied with a decision made by the Traffic & Parking Commission, you may appeal the decision by filing for a writ of certiorari with the Davidson County Chancery or Circuit Court. Your appeal must be filed within 60 days of the date of the entry of the Commission’s decision. We advise that you seek your own independent legal advice to ensure that your appeal is filed in a timely manner and that all procedural requirements have been met.”

Consent Agenda

1. **Proposal No. 2015M – 002AB – 001** – A request to abandon Alley # 701.5 from 31st Ave N to Alley # 719 (easements and utilities to be abandoned and relocated), requested by Barge Waggoner, Sumner & Cannon, Inc. Applicant: LLU Opus 31, LLC, property owner
2. **Proposal No. 2015M – 003AB – 001** – A request to abandon Unnumbered Alley # 701 southeastward to its terminus (easements and utilities to be relocated), requested by Dewey – Estes Engineering, applicant; JJB Properties, LLC. Owasso Development, LLC. Michael Sullivan Builders GP, property owners.

1. The first part of the document discusses the importance of maintaining accurate records of all transactions. It emphasizes that proper record-keeping is essential for the integrity of the financial system and for the ability to detect and prevent fraud.

- Authorize no parking on both sides of Hampton St. from W Trinity Lane to Avondale Circle
- Authorize no parking on both sides of Avondale Circle from Brick Church Pk to Hampton St
- Authorize no parking on the south side of Avondale Cr from Hampton St to 450' west of Hampton St

Commissioner Morin requested that the modification of speed limit from 35 mph to 30 mph on Jocelyn Hollow from Davidson Dr. to dead end be **removed from the consent agenda and deferred one month.**

Mr. Green made a motion to remove the requested items from the consent agenda, seconded by Ms. Mary Vavra and **approved with no opposition.**

Councilman Harrison made a motion to defer one month, seconded by Mr. Green and **approved with no opposition.**

Mr. Green made a motion to approve the revised agenda, seconded by councilman Harrison and **approved with no opposition.**

1. Authorize no parking or standing on both sides of Brandywine Dr (# 500-508) from 2:00 – 3:30pm, Monday thru Friday
