Chairman Feller Brown called the meeting of October 10, 2016 to order at 3:00 p.m.

CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Feller Brown mentioned Ordinance No. BL2006-1050 regarding the appeals process of the Traffic and Parking Commission.

"If you are not satisfied with a decision made by the Traffic & Parking Commission, you may appeal the decision by filing for a writ of certiorari with the Davidson County Chancery or Circuit Court. Your appeal must be filed within 60 days of the date of the entry of the Commission's decision. We advise that you seek your own independent legal advice to ensure that your appeal is filed in a timely manner and that all procedural requirements have been met."

Ms. Kern moved for **approval** of the minutes, seconded by Mrs. Woods and **approved with no opposition.**

Ms. Vavra made a **motion to remove items B and E** for discussion and **completely remove Item D**, seconded by Mrs. Woods and **approved with no opposition.**

Mr. Knauf stated on behalf of the Council Member, he would like to request a one month deferral of Item B.

Ms. Vavra made a motion to **defer Item B for one month**, seconded by Ms. Kern and **approved with no opposition**.

Ms. Vavra asked why Public Works wants to remove the no right on red on 42nd Ave at Charlotte.

Mr. Knuaf stated that this use to be a school for the blind, he noted that it is no longer occupied and that the sign can be removed.

Ms. Vavra made a **motion to approve**, seconded by Ms. Williams and **approved with no opposition**.

New Business

1. A request to appeal the denial of a traffic signal on Jo Johnston Ave at 16th Ave N. Requested by Council Member at Large, Erica Gilmore.

Council Lady Gilmore expressed the need for a safer intersection for the students at this school . She noted that there is a parking lot across the street that the students have to walk to before and after school.

Dr. Ray noted that she was the principal for this school and she supports the signal.

During discussion of this traffic signal, Public Works agreed to install a stop sign at this location and the stop sign is to remain until the traffic signal is complete.

Ms. Vavra made a **motion to approve**, seconded by Ms. Williams and **approved with no opposition**.

2. Loading Zone – Main St at Neil Ave; Holiday Jones Development, Dean Design Group, applicant.

Ms. Vavra made a motion to **defer for one month**, seconded by Ms. Woods and approved with no opposition.

Old Business

1. Assignment Agreement and Second Amendment to the Parking Agreement for the Stahlman Building tenants' usage of 175 spaces in the Courthouse Public Square parking garage.

Ms. Woods made a motion to approve, seconded by Ms. Kern and approved with no opposition.

Traffic and Parking Commission Resolution No. 16-10 authorized by Chapter 9 of the Charter of the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, Tennessee as amended

BE IT RESOLVED by the Traffic and Parking Commission of the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, Tennessee as follows:

SECTION I: That Chapter 12 of said Metropolitan Code, said Chapter being entitled 'Vehicles and Traffic' is amended as follows:

SECTION II. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution be published in a daily newspaper in Metropolitan Nashville/Davidson County, Tennessee, and that a certified copy be filed with the Chief of Police of the Metropolitan Police Department, and that a certified copy be filed with the Metropolitan clerk, and that said Resolution take effect five (5) days thereafter.

The above mentioned Resolution items were previously approved under the Consent Agenda.
