- *Announcement of Appeals Process*, Metropolitan Code of Laws 2.68.030:

“If you are not satisfied with a decision made by the Traffic & Parking Commission, you may appeal the decision by filing for a writ of certiorari with the Davidson County Chancery or Circuit Court. Your appeal must be filed within 60 days of the date of the entry of the Commission’s decision. We advise that you seek your own independent legal advice to ensure that your appeal is filed in a timely manner and that all procedural requirements have been met.”

- a) **CD21:** Proposal 2017M-026AB-001 – Abandon a portion of John L Driver, from 38th Avenue N to 37th Avenue N, and a portion of 37th Avenue N, from John L Driver Avenue to Tigerelle Drive – easements to be retained; requested by Tennessee State University, applicant
- b) **CD21:** Modify taxi stand located on the north side of 1808 West End Avenue to a taxi stand and loading zone; requested by Metro Public Works
- c) **CD19:** Authorize valet stand at 118 7th Avenue North, 24 hours – 7 days a week; requested by Parking Management
- d) **CD19:** Modify taxi stand located on the east side of 4th Avenue S at Broadway to a taxi stand from 04:00am-11:00am and loading zone from 11:00am-04:00am; requested by Metro Public Works
- e) **CD06:** Modify speed limit on Davidson Street from 30mph to 20mph from Shelby Park entrance to 100’ west of S 14th Street
- f) **CD02:** Install new traffic signal at Brick Church Pike and Woodfolk Avenue
- g) **CD28:** Implement truck restriction (over 8 tons) on all roads off of Richards Rd between Una-Antioch and Debra Drive. Includes, Delta, Lori, Drewery, McBride, Richards Ct, Bowfield, and Debra. Also, includes Reeves Rd from Una-Antioch to Bowfield Drive – requested by Council Member Vercher

- 1. **CD19:** Authorize rate increase at the Public Square Garage at 350 Deaderick Street and Library Garage at 151 6th Avenue North; requested by Nashville Downtown Partnership
- 2. **CD19 & CD05:** Modify speed limit on James Robertson Parkway from 40mph to 35 mph from Church Street to Spring Street; deferred from November 2017 meeting
- 3. **CD17:** Appeal denial of prohibition of left turn movement from 4:00pm-6:00pm M-F on Napoleon Avenue at Nolensville Pike; requested by CM Sledge
