**03-22-03** Centennial Park Conservancy requests the Board to accept a grant in the amount of \$16,642.00 to fund the continuation of a part-time position in the Parthenon Museum Store for the 2022-2023 fiscal year (July 1, 2022 – June 30, 2023). This grant will be distributed via quarterly reimbursement to Metro Parks and requires no match or other obligation.
