

Davidson County Election Commission

March 11, 2022 9:00 a.m.

The Davidson County Election Commission (DCEC) met at 9:00 a.m. in the Green Hills Conference Room at Metro Southeast. Commissioners Jim DeLanis, Dan Davis, Tricia Herzfeld, and A. J. Starling were present. Commissioner Ross Evans and Administrator of Elections (AOE) Roberts were not present. DCEC staff members present included Courtney Mott, John Hite, Bobby Medley, and Kelley Harrison.
