Proposal demonstrated firm's staff diversity, to include having hearing impaired staff members. Proposal demonstrated firm's medical and legal experience. Proposal demonstrated firm's experience responding in emergency disaster situations. Proposal demonstrated firm's ECC experience. Proposal demonstrated and welcoming approach providing services to the deaf community. Firm's proposal demonstrated and provided all other required information with the exception of the weaknesses noted below.

Weaknesses

Interpreters Unlimited

Proposal demonstrated firm's experience and years of service in the industry. Proposal demonstrated firm's charitable contributions, showing the firm donates 2% profit to local charities. Proposal demonstrated firm's experience working with Government entities, with over 2,000 contracts with both local and State Governments. Proposal demonstrated firm's experience with mental health, medical and legal. Firm's project approach includes using an IU System. * Firm offers incentive for delayed services. Firm's proposal demonstrated and provided all other required information with the exception of the weaknesses noted below.

Weaknesses

Firm's proposal failed to address and/or provide information on firm's certifications and/or licenses. Firm's proposal failed to address firm's emergency situation plan. Firm's proposed critical plan does not meet Metro's 2-hour response time. Firm's proposed method of employee monitoring is based solely on customer feedback. Firm's proposed plan for continuous quality improvement lacked detail. Firm's provided reference projects were not of similar size, scope or complexity of scope of work for this RFQ. *Proposal anticipates a delay in provided services. Firm's proposal failed to demonstrate a local presence.
