

**METROPOLITAN NASHVILLE-DAVIDSON COUNTY
TRANSPORTATION LICENSING COMMISSION**

**Minutes
January 27, 2022**

The Metropolitan Nashville-Davidson County Transportation Licensing Commission (TLC) met for a regular meeting on this date in the Jury Assembly Room of the Historic Davidson County Courthouse. Present were Chair Sal Hernandez, Vice Chair Patrick McNally and Commissioners Carey Rogers and Carol Westlake (4). Present were Metro Legal Adviser Theresa Costonis along with TLC staff members Lisa Steelman and Billy Fields.

The Chair called the meeting to order then led the Pledge of Allegiance followed by a reading of the Notice of Appeal Statement which outlined the right of appeal of TLC decisions.

Vice Chair McNally with a second from Commissioner Westlake moved approval of the previous meeting minutes:

Public Hearings

The Chair announced the annual public hearing or the consideration of applications for Certificates of Public Convenience and necessity for taxicabs. Director Fields explained that there were no applications for new certificates or any applications for modified certificates.

No action was required by the TLC.

The Chair called for a public hearing for the purpose of considering the booting services application from Tristar Enforcement LLC. Director Fields explained that a public hearing was required by the Metropolitan Code of Law in section 6.81. Hunter Kitchens was present representing the company. There were no requests to speak so the hearing was closed.
