

**METROPOLITAN NASHVILLE-DAVIDSON COUNTY
TRANSPORTATION LICENSING COMMISSION**

**Minutes
February 24, 2022**

The Metropolitan Nashville-Davidson County Transportation Licensing Commission (TLC) met for a regular meeting on this date in the Jury Assembly Room of the Historic Davidson County Courthouse. Present were Vice Chair Patrick McNally and Commissioners Monna Lisa Warren, Freddie Carr, Jessica Powell, Michael Hayes, Betsy Williams and Carol Westlake (7).
