Strengths: Firm demonstrated relevant experience of proposed team members and subcontractors. Firm described and provided documentation on five (5) projects of similar size, scope and complexity. Firm provided a detailed plan of how they plan to manage the project.

Weaknesses: Firm did not include water main survey information. Firm did not identify specifically what portion of work subcontractors will be responsible performing. Firm did not provide complete final costs of construction for example projects.

Barge Design Solutions

Strengths: Firm provided a complete organizations work chart for their key personnel on the project. Firm explained the specific reason why their firm is the best choice to be awarded the project.

Weaknesses: Firm did not include water main survey information. Firm did not demonstrate relevant team member experience for water projects. Firm did not provide documentation on five (5) projects of similar size, scope and complexity. Firm did not provide specific examples of similar previous projects that address the coordination of work.

Lamar Dunn and Associates, Inc.

Strengths: Firm demonstrated their organizations quality assurance/safety/Errors and Omissions record.

Weaknesses: Firm did not demonstrate relevant team member experience for water projects. Firm did not provide subcontractors who will work in conjunction with them. Firm did not provide a detailed narrative of their understanding of the project and how they will accomplish the desired deliverables. Firm did not demonstrate efficient use of manpower, resources and technology to complete the project efficiently.

OHM Advisors

Strengths: Firm provided a detailed plan on how they they proposed to manage the project.

Weaknesses: Firm did not demonstrate relevent team member experience for water projects. Firm did not provide subcontractors who will work in conjunction with them. Firm did not provide documentation on five (5) projects of similar size, scope and complexity. Firm did not provide final design and construction costs for all relevent projects. Firm did not provide a detailed narrative of their understanding of the project and how they will accomplish the desired deliverables. Firm did not demonstrate efficient use of manpower, resources and technology to complete the project effeciently.

SMITH SECKMAN REID INC

Strengths: Firm provided a complete organizations work chart for their key personnel on the project. Firm explained the specic reason why their firm is the best choice to be awarded the project. Firm provided a detailed plan on how they they proposed to manage the project.

Weaknesses: Firm did not deliniate between water main survey and design projects over the last five (5) years. Firm did not provide documentation on five (5) projects of similar size, scope and complexity. Firm did provide adequate plan/approach to minimize impacts to industries/residents and the public during construction.
