Proposal demonstrated firm's experience working on high profile site locations. Firm's proposal demonstrated and provided all other required information with the exception of the weaknesses noted below.

Weaknesses

Proposal lacked detail under qualifications and capacity demonstrating firm's archeological experience. Firm failed to provide resumes for key team members. Proposal lacked detail for project approach and experience demonstrating firm's experience with and/or knowledge of the secretary of the interior's standards for the treatment of historic properties and for firm's proposed archeological protocols.
