<u>STEP I</u>

To apply to take the examination for a license as a *Metropolitan Master Electrician, Equipment Installer, Low Voltage Installer,* or a *Journeyman Electrician* you must complete the Examination application form with <u>all</u> information requested. Applications are to be submitted to the Department of Codes and Building Safety. Incomplete applications <u>will not</u> be accepted.

STEP II

Upon receipt of your application, it will be reviewed and considered by the Chief Electrical Inspector.

Upon approval, you will receive notification by e-mail with instructions on how to schedule your exam. We will include the Examination Summary and Study Guide references for the classification you requested.

It will be your responsibility to schedule your examination date with Prov. You may contact Prov at 866-720-7768 or https://provexam.com. Those applicants being administered the Master Plumbers examination will also be administered the Septic Tank and Overflow examination.
